Sarah all my property Except such part as must be
left to pay my lawful & funeral expenses such property
as may be left, to be divided by my wife & family to
pay the debts, the remainder to be in possession of my wife
Sarah during her life or widowhood & then to be
left & equally divided between my children

I hereby appoint Aaron Damron
my Executor to this my last Will & Testament
