Thomas Sprats Will

I Thomas Sprat of the County of Lincoln and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make and declare this my last will and testament in manner and form following. That is to say first that my executor hereinafter named shall provide for my body a decent burial suitable to the wishes of my relatives & friends & pay all funeral expenses together with my just debts wherem & whereupon owing by me of the money that may just come into his hands as a part or parcel of my estate.

Article 2^d. I give & bequeath to my daughter Charlotte one good Cow & Calf, also two Beds and Furniture belonging thereto. Also one Bureau made by her.

Article 3^d. I give & bequeath to my daughter Margaret one Cow & Calf, also two Beds and Furniture belonging thereto. Also one Bureau

Article 4th I give & bequeath to my Daughter Phely
Our Cow & Calf also Five Beds furniture be-
longing therto also One Beard or Its Equiv-
alent in Money --

Article 5th My Will & Desire is that my Execu-
tor hereinafter named is to Learn as much
of my Property on the place as will be
Sufficient to Care for the Business of Farming
as to Make for them a Support as long as they
May remain as a Family as they did in my
Life time - wife &

Article 6th I further desire that my Negro
woman Ciss is to remain in my family as
long as they keep a house.

Article 7th I further will & bequeath that all of
my Lands & all other Effects that has not been
dispensed of in former Clauses of this my will
is to be Equally Divided between all of my
Children that is to say Martha & Margaret
and Phely & John F & Lucy J and George J
& Julius a & Thomas H. & Spratt, & Lastly I do
hereby constitute & appoint

be sufficient to carry on the Business of farm-
ing as to make for them a Support as long
as they may remaine as a family as they did
in my life time

Art. 6th I further will & desire that my
Negro woman Lipp do to remaine in my
family as long as they keep ~~house~~,

Art 7th I further will & bequeath that all
of my Lands & all other Effects that has
not been Disposed of in former Clauses
of this my will is to be Equally divided
