lands that I have decided to Daniel Linhardt
and John Linhardt's children during her natural
lifetime or in default of that either of the above
named persons the property & land to be distributed
as is herein ^{after} mentioned; In case she outlives my
widow until death I allow all the personal
property to be divided amongst my children or
their heirs that is Sarah Linhardt formerly wife
of David Backus, Daniel, Joseph, John, Larana
Linhardt & Barbara Linhardt formerly wife
of John Black, each an equal share,
and in case my wife Elizabeth should
change her way of living I allow her to
have two cows & calves & all the house hold &
kitchen furniture of every description the balance
to be divided as above mentioned
3d I allow the house or parcel of land I now live
on forming a kind of David Backus & the tract of land
decided by me to Daniel Linhardt & the heirs of
John Linhardt at my wife's death or marriage
to be equally divided between Virginia Linhardt
Elizabeth & Benjamin Linhardt & the son that Susannah
Linhardt now dwells in supposed to be pregnant with
at this time, heirs of Jacob Linhardt deceased
