Vincent Woods Will

State of N. Carolina, I, Vincent Wood being of sound mind and
 Sincere County, S. Memory. but. Considering the uncertainty of my
 earthly existence do make and declare this my last Will & Testament
 in manner & form following that is to say First that my Executors
 hereinafter named shall provide for my body a decent burial
 suitable to the wishes of my Relations and friends and pay all
 funeral expenses, together with my just debts out of the money
 that may first come into the hands of my Executors as a part
 of my Estate

Item 2^d I give and bequeath unto my son Absalom Wood
 all the property that is on the place that my son Absalom now
 lives on I also give and bequeath to my son Absalom a piece of Land
 known as the Mill tract Containing seventy two acres also one other
 tract or piece of my old tract that is unsold supposed to be Twenty
 four acres to be his forever, For and in Consideration of the above Twenty
 four acre tract my son Absalom Wood is to pay to my Estate fifty
 Dollars to be equally divided between my three daughters that is
 to say Miss Mary Farmer & Elizabeth Wood

Item 3^d I give and devise to my daughter Elizabeth Wood the tract
 of land she now lives on Containing Forty acres or thereabouts
 and also an entry of three acres or thereabouts running with Henry
 Stearns line

and also an entry of three acres or thereabouts
I have now lives on containing forty acres or thereabouts
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Item 4th I give and bequeath to my son John H. Wood one & 1/2
acre I have against him dated 23rd day of March 1858

Item 5th I give and devise to my daughter Mary Wier one acre
for \$100.00 on his own substance dated 30th May 1857

Item 6th I give and devise to my daughter Nancy Farmer a note which
I have paid for her husband David Farmer to Major Hull for \$83.73.
dated 13th of April 1850.

Item 7th My Will further is that after my death my Executors is to
Collect all of my debts due my estate and pay all of my Just debts and
funeral expenses the balance to be equally divided between my
son John H. Wood and my three daughters that is to say Mary
Wier Nancy Farmer & Elizabeth Wood, And lastly I do hereby con-
-stitute and appoint my two sons John H. Wood and Abner Wood
my lawful Executors to all intents & purposes to execute this my
last Will and Testament according to the true intent and meaning
of the same, and every part thereof. Hereby Resolving all other
wills by me made in Witness whereof I the said Vincent Wood do
set my hand and seal this the 28th day of April 1861. Signed Sealed
Published & declared by the said Vincent Wood to be his last Will &
Testament in the presence of us as subscribing Witnesses
