In the name of God Amen I give & make my Last Will & Testament  
County of Meckl. of North Carolina Being an old man,  
but of perfect mind & memory I make this to give, unto  
Almighty God, Calling unto mind the mortality of  
my body & knowing that is appointed unto men once  
to die. Do make & ordain this my last will & testament  
that is to say principally & first of all. I give & command  
My soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it  
& My body I command to the Earth to be buried in a  
decent Christian burial at the discretion of my executors  
Nothing doubting but at the General resurrection I shall  
receive the same again by the almighty power of God.

And as touching such worldly Estate wherewithal I  
hath pleased God to bless me within this life, I give & command  
of the same in the following manner If in

I give to my Daughter Sally Fisher or her heirs five  
Shillings after my decease to be paid when called for  
by my Executors. When Called for five Shillings to  
Potley Purbind or his heirs & five Shillings to my daughter  
Elizabeth Alexander or her heirs & five Shillings to my  
son Wm Fish or his heirs & to my daughter Elizabeth Fish  
ward five Shillings to her or her heirs to my son  
Isaac Fish or his heirs five Shillings & to my daughter  
Sarah Purbind or her heirs five Shillings & to son  
John Fish or his heirs five Shillings. Then to my daughter  
Dolly Douglass or her heirs five Shillings. Then after  
all my just debts are paid & back of the above named  
legacies paid, Together with my funeral expenses to  
my wife, I give & Bequeath, And my wife and I have  
is after the decease of me & my wife, That my son  
Braxton Fish takes Care of us while we live  
them all my Estate both Real & personal. That

County of Lincoln State of South Carolina being very sick and  
weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thank be to God

I recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God  
that gave it & my body I recommend to the earth to be  
buried in decent Christian burial at the discretion of my executors  
and as touching such earthly estate wherewithal it hath pleased  
God to bless me in this life, I give devise & dispose of the same  
in the following manner of form.

First I give and bequeath to Lucretia my dearly beloved wife  
so long as she remains a widow, after paying all my  
just debts, all my lands & negroes. Household goods  
personal & moveable Estates to devide among our  
children at her discretion and pleasure both before and  
after they come of age.
