State of North Carolina & Craven County know all
by these presents & to whom it may concern that I
William Wilson of the State & County aforesaid do
make & constitute the following articles to be my last
Will & Testament & do dispose of my estate real & personal
as follows. Being on my health & it would serve &
Memory do Will that all my just debts with my
Funeral expenses be paid.

It will be my wish when Helen Langster my
now living with one two named Richard in property
to be valued by my executors & my executors to take
her property into their hands & do appoint my
executors the said Langster's guardian to have her act
they may think she needs it. I do so further will
the remainder of my property, real & personal to my
wife Jean during her natural life then to the
heirs of her body born to me of my I will appoint
Samuel Langster & my wife Jean my executors -
of this my last will & testament for consumption
whereof it do revoke & make void all other wills
by me made. Wherefore I hand & seal this eighteenth
day of September in the year One Thousand
Eight Hundred & Twenty Eight
