Open Court & Ordered to be Recorded

In the name of god amen I
William Potter of the County & State of North
Carolina being weak in body but of sound mind
& calling to mind that it is the lot of all men
to die, Therefore in Order to settle my worldly affairs
do make this my last Will & Testament

First I will that all my just debts & funeral
charges be paid out of my estate by my executor
hereinafter named. Second it is my will & I do

hereby constitute & appoint my friend Oliver W
Holland my sole executor & I do authorize him
the said Holland to gather my present crop
or hire a hand or hands to do it & that he &
there be paid a reasonable compensation out of
said crop after make in sale of the same in
the best way that he my executor may think proper
& after disposing of my estate & settling all the just
debts & necessary expenses, the balance I bequeath
to my Betty Potter during her lifetime, which is to
be given to her in such sum, & at at such times
as my executor may think proper. I do also hereby
revoke & disannul all former wills & make this my
my last will & Testament Given under my hand
& seal this 24th day of August A.D. 1835
