

January Sessions. 1837

In the name of god amen I William Wilson of the County of Lincoln & State of North Carolina being of Sound & perfect mind & memory - (blessed be god for his mercy towards me) do this 21st day of November in the year of our Lord 1836. Make & publish this my last will & testament in manner following that is to say

1st I Give & bequeath unto my beloved Sabella Wilson all of my land on the West side of Little Creek of Buffalo. Beginning on a Stake on the outside line, on the West bank of the Creek thence up the Creek as it meanders to a Stake on the outside line thence with the outside line to the beginning during her natural lifetime or widowhood my crop man & one set of year, get to plow with all of my Cattle all my sheep her Choice of one half of my Hogs all of my goods & all of my household & Kitchen furniture & every name Description & my iron & guns of every description during her natural lifetime or widowhood

2nd I Give & bequeath unto my son Robert Wilson all of my land on the East side of Little Creek of Buffalo. Beginning on a Stake on the outside line on the West bank of the Creek thence up the Creek as it meanders to a Stake on the outside line thence with the outside line to the beginning and likewise all the above mentioned land & premises that I left to my beloved wife to be his at either of the above mentioned persons at her death or changing from being my widow and also all my farming tools of every value & description & the balance of Hogs not left to my beloved wife above mentioned

3rd I Give & bequeath unto my daughter Mary Wilson now wife of William Wilson

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My son James Wilson My son John Wilson
My son Samuel Wilson My daughter Eleanor
Wilson now wife of John Hall My son William
Wilson My daughter Sabella Wilson now wife
of William Bigham one dollar each

If the lastly I give & bequeath unto my beloved
wife Sabella Wilson & my son Robert Wilson
all my money notes, & book amounts & debts due
me & all property of every description not
heretofore mentioned, each an equal share

And I hereby make & ordain my worthy
friend William Bigham Executor of this my
last will & Testament. In witness whereof I
the said William Wilson have to this my
last will & Testament set my hand & seal
the day & year above written
