In the name of god amon I William Wilson of the County of Lincoln & State of North Carolina being of sound & perfect mind in memory (blessed be god for his mercy toward me) do the 21st day of November in the year of our Lord 1836 make & publish this my last will & testament in manner following that is to say

1st I give & bequeath unto my beloved Isabella Wilson all of my land on the east side of Little Creek of Buffalo Beginning on a Stake on the outside line, on the west bank of the Creek thence up the Creek as it meanders to a Stake on the east side line thence with the east side line to the beginning changing her natural lifetimes or widowhood my wife more & one half of years fit to plow with all of my cattle etc in & of herself her choice of one half of my dogs all to my good & all of my household & kitchen furniture every name D'Urgoation & my iron & guns of every description during her natural lifetime & widowhood

2^d I give an bequeath unto my son Robert Wilson all of my land on the East side of Little Creek of Buffalo Beginning on a Stake on the east side line on the west bank of the Creek thence up the Creek as it meanders to a Stake on the east side line thence with the east side line to the beginning and likewise all the above mentioned land & premises that I left to my beloved wife to be his at either of the above mentioned places at her death or changing from being my widow and also all my farming tools of every value & description & the balance of dogs not left to my beloved wife above mentioned

3^r I give & bequeath unto my daughter Mary Wilson now wife of Wm King Calhoun
