In the name of God Amen I Abner Williams (A.D.) of the Town of Williamston
County of Martin & State of North Carolina being of sound disposing mind and
Memory do make and publish this my last will and testament in the
following manner and form. hereby annulling concealing and
overuling all other former wills & testaments & prior writings in the
nature of wills which at any time heretofore may have been made
or executed by me viz.

Empress my wife and dear is that my mortal remains after death
be taken charge of by my friend George Johnson of Williamston and laid
out & buried in the Elizabeth City Burying Ground County N.C. and thereafter
it to my friend Wm. H. Griffin who will have it very decently buried in my grave
and in care Elizabeth City for how the said grave you will substantially enclose
and have other grave stones or monuments erected over my grave with such
inscription as he may think proper and the amount he may be paid
about the same - my funeral & burial as well as enclosing &c giving
and tomb & gravestones is left entirely to the discretion of the said Wm. H. Griffin
where I shall have appointed my Executor also my Executor is hereby requested
to make my friend George Johnson ample compensation for all the
trouble, attention & expense he may be put to concerning the necessary burial
clothes coffin & carrying me comes to Elizabeth City as aforesaid & his retaining
& time he may carry with him - after paying for the above & any other
incurred & funeral expenses as well as my just debts

Secondly I give bequeath & leave to my friend Wm. H. Griffin of Elizabeth
City Burying Ground County N.C. Carolina the sum of five hundred dollars
for any trouble he may be put to in carrying out the objects & intent
of & contained in the foregoing clause of this my last will and
testament and which to take in lieu & instead of any charge of him
for consumption on my estate for settling the same

Thirdly I give bequeath & leave to my beloved Sister Susan Williams &
her heirs adme & - a legacy forever of the balance of my effects
action & in possession as well as all my property & estate of every kind
Character & description which may remain after paying for carrying
out the objects & intentions mentioned in the above first clause a clause of
this my will & also paying the legacy contained in the second clause &
sum of my will

Fourthly I nominate & constitute & appoint my worthy & much esteemed friend
the aforesaid Wm. H. Griffin of the town of Elizabeth City Burying Ground County N.C.
Carolina sole Executor of & to this my last will and testament as testimony
whereof I the said Abner Williams so humbly setting my hand & seal thereto
this the 19th day of February 1857. having first published & pronounced
and declared by the said Abner Williams as his last will and
testament in my presence and we in his presence & in presence
of each other subscribers
