 lands where I now live after her mothers death the lower part
 from the above mentioned branch all below to be for her
 & enough of the estate to be sold for money raised to purchase
 her a Negro Girl to be her heirs for ever
 Item I give & bequeath to Daughter Sally the lands & plantation
 on the middle swamp that I bought of Wm. Howell & S. Perry
 & the Negro Girl that is for my wife during her widow hood
 then is to go to Sally my Daughter in case there remains any
 thing to be equally divided between my two Daughters
 Phraby & Sally I constitute & appoint my Brothers
 Jordan Watson & Arthur Watson Executors to this my last
 will & Testament here unto I set my hand & Seal in
 presence of these Witnesses this November 6th Day 99

 her increase when she arrives to the age of twenty one to her her heirs
 & assigns for ever I give & bequeath to my well
 beloved Daughter Nancy Carraway my Negro woman Turner and her
 increase when she arrives to the age of twenty one to her her heirs
 & assigns for ever I give & bequeath to my well
 beloved son Joseph Gainer Carraway all my lands &
 plantation the land that I bought of Thos. Turner he is
 to Receive at the age of Twenty one years the mortgage
 plantation at my wifes Death to him his heirs & assigns
 for ever it is my will & desire that all the Remaining part of
 my estate be equally divided between all my Children when
 my Daughter Nancy Carraway arrives to the age of Twenty one
 years that is Joseph Gainer Carraway Phraby Carraway
 Tompy Carraway & Nancy Carraway to them their heirs & assigns
 forever lastly I constitute & appoint my beloved wife Sarah
 Carraway & my friend John Beardslee Executors & authorize to this
 my last will & Testament hereby revoking & Disannulling
 all former wills by me made & Ratifying & Confirming
 this & No other to be my last will & Testament in witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 22nd Day
 of March 1880 Signed Sealed & published & Declared by the
 David Carraway to be his last will & Testament in presence
