

In the Name of God Amen I Malachi Chapple of the State of North Carolina and County of Martin this the second day of Sept^r in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and eleven do make and ordain this my last will and testament that is to say Principally & first of all I give my soul into the hands of god who I am it me & my body to the Earth to be buried in a christen like manner at the direction of my Executors and as touching my worldly good it hath pleased god to bless me with in this life I give Demise & Dispose of in the following manner & form

And first I Desire that all my Just Debts be paid out of my Estate = I Give to my loving wife Sarah Chapple all my Estate Real and Personal both within and without (only three small negroes Name by Lumber, Eldie & Martin, bequeathd. During her Lifetime or widowhood and at her Death or marriage to be as here after mentioned = I Give to my Daughter Minnie Rogers at the Death or marriage of my wife, my negroes Blaisy, Lamb, Anthony, with two hundred and fifty Dollars, to her & her heirs for ever = Then I give to my Daughter Mildy Rogers, at the Death or marriage of my wife, one hundred acres of Land that she now lives upon my negroes, Peter, Eldie & Harry to her and heirs for ever = Then I give to my Daughter Nancy Askew, at the Death or marriage of my wife, the Land & Plantations whereon I now live with all there unto belonging, also my Negroes, Duke, Sale & Martin, to her and her heirs for ever = Then I give to Rebecca J. Biggs fifty Dollars, or one years work of one of my negro men which ever she and my wife shall chuse to her and her heirs for ever = And I further Give that at the Death or marriage of my wife all my Property that I have not given in Legacies be Equally Divided to twain my three Daughters Namely, Minnie Rogers, Mildy Rogers & Nancy Askew, and further I Direct & Chose George Rogers, John Rogers, & Allen Askew my Executors to this my last will & Testament Ratifying & confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament in confirmation of which I Malachi Chapple have hereunto set my hand & seal this the second day of September one thousand Eight hundred & Eleven Signed sealed & Delivered by Malachi Chapple to be his last will & testament in presence of us

 Martin County } of the County and State aforesaid now being in perfect mind and memory thanks be to god for the same calling to mind the mortality of man and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make & ordain this my last will & Testament in manner following (Wit) I Give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Sarah King the Plantations whereon she now lives and all the Land's belonging thereto I also give all my household and kitchen furniture to my ^{be my wife's separate property} last wife Sarah King my Stock of Horses containing one bay mare name Sarah later on several more name billow one bay horse named children. I also give my said wife Sarah King all of my corn & fodder to make use of as she may see think proper I leave all my stock of cattle and hogs to be sold to satisfy all my Just Debts and if there should be a balance after my Just debts Executors be satisfied I give and assign my wife to have it & also give the Residue of my farming utensils after all my lawful debts are satisfied unto my wife Sarah King for ever I also give unto Starbuck Ruffin my gun to have and to hold for use it is further my will and desire that my executor should hold the above mentioned property and set on it as he may think proper for the use of my wife Sarah King. I promote and appoint my worthy friend John Ruffin executor to this my last will and testament and if he should die or remove away I nominate my friend Thomas Ruffin executor in his stead in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand my hand and seal to this my last will and testament
