That I give and bequeath to be my well beloved son David Lilly the Land and a plantation where the said David Lilly has been for some time the said David Lilly doth pay to Mr. Reddish twenty five pounds that that I do owe to the said Reddish and also the appraisement of my execution my wife Mary Lilly and David Lilly in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this first Day of June 1784

I have and bequeath to my son Edmund Murph my Manse of Cotton with all my lands adjoining the same and likewise my four years of his pay But if my son Edmund Murph should Die without I leave his body I will that my said Land be Equally Divided between my two sons to wit William & James Murph to them and their heirs for ever I leave I will and bequeath to my two sons William and James Murph a number of three years Old with all her Increase to be Equally Divided between my two sons when they shall arrive to the Age of twenty one years I will and bequeath to my son John Murph one hundred and fifty pounds I will and bequeath to my Daughter Rachel Murph one hundred and fifty pounds I will and bequeath to my Daughter Martha Murph one hundred and fifty pounds I will and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Murph one hundred and fifty pounds I will and bequeath to my Daughter Rebecca Murph all the remainder part of my freeable Estate to use and Improve of as shall think Proper and I do constitute ordain and appoint John Padgett Executor and my Wife Rebecca Murph Executrix of this my last will and Testament and I do hereby utterly Disannul and revoke all and Every other former Testaments Wills Legacies and Bequests Religious and Concerning this and no other to be my last will and Testament In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 22 Day of November in the Year of Our Lord 1784
