or parcel of my Estate —

I give and devise unto my beloved mother
all of my Lands and my part and share in the Lands of all
which I held for collection against Benjamin Wilson and out the money
that my said Mother now owns me at the time to be her
and let her dispose absolutely and forever —

And Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my trustee
and lawful Broker William Brown Counter to all authority and
powers to execute this my last will and Testament according
to the true intent and meaning of the same and every part thereof
in behalf of my self and declaring utterly void all other wills
and Testaments of me hitherto made — In witness whereof I
do hereunto set my hand and seal this 10th day of April 1844

of North Carolina, and County of Martin being weak and failing health
of body but of perfect mind and memory, desiring to amend the
mortality of the body and having that it is appointed for all to die
so mortal and publish this last will and Testament in manner
and form following —

On 1st April I give and bequeath to my son Samuel Shiphard
and his heirs forever the following Estates, Real, Personal and Chattel —

On 2nd April I give and bequeath to my son Thomas Shiphard
and his heirs forever the following Estates, Real and Chattel —

On 3rd April I give and bequeath to my Grandson Lee S. Gales
the following chattels, Amanda Lewis and Maudie to him and
her heirs forever —

On 4th April I give and bequeath to my Great Grandchildren
Augustus Mend, England and Mend, Sarah Moon and Catharine
Brown the children of Edmund and Catharine Moon and their
heirs forever the following negroes, Far & City —

On 5th April I give and bequeath to my son Thomas Shiphard
and my Grandson Lee S. Gales and their heirs forever, the
trust of Land lying in the Islands which used to be of the estate
of my Father known by the name of the Pepper and Cherry Tree
grids tract containing two hundred acres more or less to be equally
divided between them —

On 6th April I give and bequeath to my son Samuel Shiphard
and to his heirs forever all my right title claim and interest in
all the other Lands I posses not mentioned above —

On 7th April I give and bequeath to my Great Granddaughter
England Mend One Pds, my son Samuel Shiphard can
retain possession of it until she becomes twenty years old —

On 8th April I give and bequeath to my Grandson Lee S.
Gales all Lots or other claims I have against him —

On 9th April I give and bequeath to my Grandchildren —
Elizabeth May, Frances Bradley, Samuel Bradley, Maria and
Jane Smithwick Fifty Dollars to be equally divided
between them —

On 10th April I give and bequeath to my son Samuel Shiphard
and to his heirs forever all my Cattle, and all my house hold
and kitchen furniture —

On 11th April I give and bequeath to my son Samuel Shiphard
after paying my just debts and my funeral expenses and the
fifty Dollars legacy mentioned above to my Grandchildren
Elizabeth Francis, Francis Margaret and Ode all my Lots
and acreage land money, and all articles not mentioned
and I constitute and appoint my said Son Samuel Shiphard
and Thomas Shiphard my Counter to this my last will and Testament
