Will & Testament first & principally I recommend my soul into
the hands of God that gave it & as to my worldly Affairs
I leave In manner & form following to wit first & principally
I give to my son John Smithwick 100 Acres of Land whereon he now
lives 50 Acres more down in the Neck none by the Name of the Daffney
Island 50 Acres more of the June bog Land I also give to Samuel
Smithwick 100 Acres of Land whereon he now lives with 50 Acres
of Land in the Neck joining the same old farmack to David Thwack
50 Acres more at the June bog Storm

Storm I give to my son Simon Smithwick 100 Acres of Land in the
Neck joining the Creek with 50 Acres of pine Woods on Spanish.

Storm I give to my son Edmund Smithwick the manner plantation
whereon I now live with one Hundred Acres thereunto belonging my
wife Deborah Smithwick his lifetime on Single Neck excepted
to gether with one Hundred acres of Land on Spanish Swamp

Storm I give to Ann Daves 50 Acres of Land whereon she now lives
& to the lawful heirs of her Body

Storm I give to my Daughter Hannah Smithwick 50 Acres of Land
in the Neck none by the bold pit punt next to Thomas -

Storm I give to Betsy Smithwick 50 Acres of Land down in the
Neck none by the name of the punchboat punt & to the Heirs of
my Land that hairent given I leave to be divided among my 4 sons
as to my Negroes I leave to be equally divided between my 4 sons
Except Nancy & for her & her increase to be equally divided between
my three daughters Anna Hannah & Betsy & as to all my other
goods & Chattels that shall ^{be} part with at Death I leave to be equally
to be equally divided among my 4 boys & thereunto after my debts
are paid I also except Cotes to work to be to the use of my wife
during her life but her increase if any to be the property of the boys & after
I rate & appraise to my son John Smith & Simon Smith as one part
to be divided the increase left by this will in witness hereof I have

my hand & seal this 6th day May 1726

In the Name of God Amen I Elizabeth Swain of the County of Boston
& State of New England being very weak in body but of Sound & disposing mind
& Memory & calling to mind the Mortality of Human Kind & Knowing
that it is once appointed for all Human men to die do make & declare
this my last will & Testament in manner & form following Viz
First I will that all my Just debts & funeral charges be paid by my
Estate out of my Estate

I Give & bequeath unto my well beloved Grand son Swain Richard
1 Bed Bedstead & furniture half a dozen pewter plates 3 pewter saucers
1 brass & garden & 1 Table to him his heirs & assigns forever

I Give & bequeath unto my well beloved daughter Nath Thwack
1 Head of Hops 1 Feather Bed & 2 Sheets & all my wearing clothes
13 Chairs 1 Matt 1 Wooling wheel 1 Tub & piggins to her & her heirs for
ever

I Give & bequeath unto my well beloved son John Swain & my
Daughter Nath Thwack all my Negroes to be equally divided between
them agreeable to gift of Father John Swain to them & their heirs
Assigns forever

I Give & bequeath to my well beloved son John Swain all the Remainder
part of my Estate to him his heirs & Assigns forever lastly I constitute
& appoint my beloved son John Swain sole Executor to this my last will &
Testaments hereby Testifying & annulling all former wills before by me
made & Testifying and confirming this & no other to be my last will
& Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
& Seal
