Then At the death or marriage of my wife I give to my son Asa Biggs the land of plantation whereon I now live all the Real Estate money & Annuities thereunto belonging or appertaining supposing there to be twenty five acres more or less with all the other property he has already Received to him & his heirs forever I am at the death or marriage of my wife I give to my Daughters Nancy Harrison Penny Hannon & Sarah Leggett my Negro man Peter Equally between them share & share alike with all the other property they have received to them & their heirs forever With the rest of my property that I have not particularly mentioned I desire that at the death or marriage of my wife to be Equally divided between all my children namely Nancy Harrison John Biggs Reuben Biggs William Biggs Penny Hannon Asa Biggs & Sarah Leggett to them & their heirs forever I desire & appoint my sons William Biggs & James Harrison Executors to this my last will of testament in Confirmation of which I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this the fifth day of November one thousand eight hundred & ten signed sealed & declared by Thaddeus Biggs to be his last will & testament in presence of us

4<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my grand son John Harrison one Cow to him his heirs and assigns for ever

5<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath unto my grand son Ole Harrison one three year old heifer to him his heirs and assigns forever

I desire that all the rest of my property that I have not hereunto fore given In Deed be Equally divided among my Loving Children and also I have by my last will and testament appointed to be my Executors and my son Asa and Sarah Leggett to be my Executors to this my last will and Testament Reserving all other wills be required by me here before made & obliging them and no other to be my last will and Testament In witness hereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal
