and County of Marion being of sound mind and Memory blessed be God -
do this Day the Twentyfifth in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and Ninety six make and Publish this my last will and testament in manner
following that is to say

First I send unto my Beloved wife all my Land During her natural life and
after her Death I give thy son Henry Sixty acres adjoining Joseph Bryant's
and Jordan Watson's and for the余llance to be equally Divided between
my two Sons Stephen and Tom - also send to Beloved wife your featherbed
and furniture her lifetime and after her death go them to be equally divided
between my four Daughters that is to say Mary, Charlotte, Tempery & Sally -
N.B. I send unto my Beloved wife all my Stock of all Descriptions but I say
if she dont raise a Bed for herself for as much of my Stock to be sold as
will make her equal in Property as the rest of my Daughters - Secondly
will and Devise is that all my Property of Stock after my wife's death to be
Equally Divided Between my five Daughters and my Son Henry - Thirdly
I give her all my Plantation utensiles tools - Lastly I do hereby nominate and
appoint my worthy friend Whitney Howell executor to this my last will & testament
in witness whereof I the said Henry Medford have hereunto set my hand and
Seal signed and Published by the said Henry Medford to be my last will and
testament in the presence of

In the Name of God Amen I Willibor Smith of North Carolina and county of Marion
Being of sound mind and Memory blessed be god do the third day of October in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & nineteen make and Publish this my last will & testament
in manner and form following - that is to say - first I give and Bequeath to my Son Aaron
Smith one hundred acres of Land to be laid off on the lower end of my Land adjoining James
Smiths one hundred acres of Land - also I give unto my son Aaron Smith one Negro man named
Bob & one white woman Bush and I give unto my son Aaron Smith the sum of twenty five Dollars to
him and his heirs forever -

Item I give unto my son Henry Smith all the Remaining part of my Land on flat swamp excepting
the three Part of the opposite Land to the use of my wife During her Lifetime or widowhood also
Excepting one hundred acres of Land to be laid off on the upper part of my Land adjoining James
Smiths Land - also I give to my son Henry Smith one Negro man named Jack one boy named Anthony
to him and his heirs forever - I also leave unto my wife Anna three Negroes Jeff & Susa, & Worthy
to her During her Lifetime or widowhood -

Item I give unto my Daughter Lucretia Smith one negro man named Jack to her and her heirs
forever also I give unto Lucretia Smith two negroes named Ezra & Abby at the Death of my wife
Anna to her and to her heirs forever also I give unto my Daughter L. Smith one hundred Dollars out
of my Vendible Property also one Fish -

Item I give unto my Daughter Spicy Knight two negro's named Jeff & Hannah to her and her heirs
forever - Item I give unto my Grandson Smith A. Young one hundred acres of Land to be laid off on the upper
part of my Land adjoining James Moore Land which Land is excepted in my son Henry Smiths
Land excepting the Life estate of Daughter Elizabeth Cherry then to him and his heirs forever -
Item I send unto my Daughter Elizabeth Cherry three negroes named Arthur, Rhoda & Little -
During her Lifetime after the Death of my Daughter Elizabeth Cherry I give unto my Grandson
Martha Moore A. Cherry one Negro named Nathan to him and his heirs forever -

Item I give unto my granddaughter Anna Cherry after the Death of her mother one negro girl
Janie Rhoda to her and her heirs forever -

Item I give unto my Granddaughter Anna Cherry after the Death of her mother one negro girl
Nancy Little to her and her heirs forever -

Item I give unto my wife Anna Smith three cows & calves three hams & pigs one barrel and
Puddingshaw & harness also three ewes & Lambs hogs sufficient for one years provision
and two feather beds & furniture - I send unto my wife Anna Smith one oval Table
During her Lifetime also I give to my wife forty Barrels of corn and a sufficient
quantity of fodder for her stock one year and I also give unto my son Henry Smith one
feather bed & furniture forever - and I also give unto my Daughter Lucretia Smith one feather bed
and furniture forever - also I send unto my grand son Smith A. Young one feather bed
& furniture for the use of his mother Elizabeth Cherry forever -

Also my will & desire is that my son Henry Smith and my Daughter Lucretia Smith have
out of my Stock three cows & calves apiece Lastly my will and Desire is the Residue
of my estate not given away in Legacies to be equally Divided Between all my
children and I hereby ordain my sons Aaron Smith & Henry Smith and my wife
friend Thomas James Executors to this my last will and testament in
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal to this my last
