3. I give to my Daughter Susan one Feather Bed Bedstead & furniture
 one Chest one Table and two Chairs and one Cow & Calf and
 one Silver Whisk
4. I give to my son Daniel Seal my horse I have taken of John
 with the exception of his paying my son Joel Seal one hundred and
 fifty Dollars of the five returns to this County Delaware when
 Daniel comes of age, also I give to him one feather Bed Bedstead and
 furniture and one Cow and Calf

5. I give to my son Joel Seal one feather Bed Bedstead
 and furniture and one Cow and Calf
 6. I give to my son Henry Seal all my Bed Bedstead and
 furniture and one feather Bed Bedstead and furniture and one

 7. I give to my son John P. Seal all my Land whereon
 I now live and one feather Bed Bedstead and furniture and one
 Cow and Calf
 8. I give to my three Daughters Elizabeth Rebecca
 and Susan Christina and my negro Child Pina bare
 of what she has there and they live in the three last that does live
 if she does not live then three Dollars give her to my three
 Daughters above mentioned that they be divided when Pina comes
 of age but if Pina have the three Children above mentioned
 in my will and mine that she and the balance of her share
 be equally divided between all my children namely Elizabeth
 Susan Christina Henry John & John P. Seal -
 9. I do my will that all my unmentioned property be sold
 and my debt paid and of any thing left is be equally divided
 between all my children above named and have above -
