Once to die, have made and obtained this to be my
last Will & Testament first of all I recommend my soul
into the hands of Almighty God who gave it & my body to
be decently Buried —

Item I give and bequeath to my Well beloved sister Fanny Made
An Negro man named Sander one two year old man on
four head of cattle ten yards of white linen to her and her heirs
for ever —

Item I give and bequeath to my Well beloved Brother William
Made One bay mare called Nancy, One piece of Buff three
yards of white lining one blue suit of clothes from cloth to
him and his heirs for ever —

Item I give & bequeath to my Well beloved Brother George
Made one bay horse called Tom one suit of blue homespun
Cloath linen and white linen one piece of moss Glazed to
him and his heirs for ever —

Item I give and bequeath to my Well beloved sister Elizabeth
Made One white linen yard White Linen, Five Dollars in
Silver to her and her heirs for ever —

Item I give and bequeath to my Well beloved father Henry
Made one third Part of a small little hogget of Thomas
& also One third Part of all the Pigger I have to sell
I give one Coat & one of Brooches of Broad Cloth & all
he has that to me belonged at the time he died and his
heirs for ever —

Item I give and bequeath to my Well beloved Brother William
Made One pair of Calfe skin shoes to him and his
heirs for ever —

Item I give & bequeath to my Well beloved Brother William
Made my services from the 1st of January 1784 to the 1st of
January 1785 for ever —

Item I give & bequeath to my Well beloved Brother Henry
Made One Gun he best that I own to him & his heirs for ever —

Item I appoint Henry Made my Father's only brother
William Made Executors to this my last Will & Testament
Revoking all other former Will or Wills by me made
Acknowledging this to be my last Will & Testament in
Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal
