Item I will and Desire is that, after the s. Lands is paid for that the s. Deeds may be read to my Beloved

My Wife Sarah Long to keep and her heirs for ever
Item I will and Desire, is that my Beloved wife Sarah Long have the work and labour of my two Negroes named as follows to wit / one Negro girl named Peter and one other Negro girl named Minny Till my Beloved Daughter Peggy Long and the one that my Beloved wife Sarah Long is now with child with

Item I will and Desire is that, after my Beloved Daughter Peggy Long and the one that my Beloved wife Sarah Long is now with child, with, comes to Lawfull age that then my said Negroes that was before mentioned and there increase be Equally Divided between my Beloved wife Sarah Long, and my Daughter Peggy, and the one that my Beloved wife Sarah Long is now with child with and to them and their heirs for ever, Lastly, I nominate and constitute and appoint my Beloved wife Sarah Long M. Luke Worlton, and James Shivers Executors to this my last will and Testament hereby Revoking and Disannulling all others heretofore by me made in Witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 6th Day of October 1777
