Item 7. I lend unto my Beloved wife Estha Hardison during her natural life one  
Negro boy named Tom with my man Plantation and all the Lands thereunto  
Belonging likewise my stock of every kind after paying my Just debts out of  
the above said stock -

Item) my will and desire is that the Property Left unto my wife during her natural  
Life be at her Death Equally Divided among my heirs at Law. And hereby  
Constitute and Ordain and appoint my Beloved Wife Esther Hardison my whole  
and sole Executrix of this my last will and testament Distributing and Resolving all  
Former wills testaments and Bequests by me made Ratifying and confirming this  
and no other to be my last will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto  
Set my hand and affixed my Seal this sixt<sup>h</sup> day of March 1833

Moore - I also bind unto my son Peter Moore one Negro man named Abraham during his life and gives  
them to his heirs Lawfully Begotten of his Body and if he never has any Children to be equally divided  
with the other heirs. - I also gives and Bequeath unto my son Josephus Moore one Church Bells also  
it is my Desire and wish that Thomas Nash shall take in hand all my Property that I have not  
gave and Lent & expense of it as he thinks proper to be most advantage for my family
