die without issue to be Equally Divided between my four Daughters
Rhoda Jenkins Annas Leggett Wines Leggett & Anne Leggett to them
& their heirs for ever
I give & bequeath to my son James Leggett half of a Negro Man named
Jack & the other half to my three grandsons Eliza Leggett William
Leggett & Daniel Leggett to be valued by Justices of the Peace
I give to my three Daughters Annas Leggett Wines Leggett & Anne
Leggett each of them one feather bed & Furniture & all my Sheep one Man
and Graveling half of their increase to be Equally divided to them
and their heirs for ever

As to my Will and devise that one half of my Movable Estate be
Equally Divided Amongst my six Daughters, To wit Sarah Pierce
Mary Summers Rhoda Jenkins Annas Leggett Wines Leggett & Anne
Leggett and the other half to my Wife during her life and then
to be Equally Among all my Children

As to my Will and devise that my Negro Man Jack serve at my Wife's
decease be Equally Divided Among my four Children Sallies
Leggett Annas Leggett Wines Leggett & Anne Leggett Personally
At last of all I constitute and Appoint my Justices of Peace
Thomas Hunter & my two Sons James Leggett and Daniel Leggett my
sole Executors to this my Last Will & Testament, attesting hereunto
disannulling & disallowing every other former Will and Testament
made by me in any kind made ratifying & confirming this & the other to be my
Last Will & Testament. In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my
hand & seal the day and Year first above Written
and James Leggett as his Last Will & Testament

I then Appoint my beloved father Ebenezer Stedman Made William Stedman
Belmont Henry Stedman Jun. Esq. & my beloved Wife Executors to this
my last Will and Testament, Ratifying all other Wills or Testaments Made
and Confirming this to be my last Will and Testament. In Witness
