

## In The Name of God Amor

I Jeremiah Stade of the county of Martin  
Being weak of Body But of sound and disposing mind and memory do make  
and admein My Last will and Testament in Manner and form following —  
Imprimis. — It Being my will and desire that all my Just debts shalbe Paid  
for that Purpose it is my will and desire that my executors hereinafter mentioned  
Shall sell all my Prouable estate not hereinbefore Bequeathed and on condition  
thereof that they sell at such Times and on such Terms as they shall think most  
advocable the following tract or Parcels of Land to wit one tract lying on the  
Crane Creek which I Purchased of James Cobb, which will appear by said  
Cobb died, also all the Lands I own on the Spring Branch, Beaver-dean and  
Turkey Swamp, as will appear by Penelope Stewart died, and the grant from  
the State to me, also two tracts of Land lying on Hunter's Pond as will appear  
from the Grants to William Stade son deceased — and it is further my will & desire  
that they sell as aforesaid so much of my Land as shall lyg Northwardly and  
Eastwardly of a Line Running from the Mouth of Wilkes Creek to Bogmane or  
a Haff uppon same and I do give and Devise aforesaid Lands and every Part  
and Parcell thereof to my executors hereinafter named thre heire and spouze in  
Trust to sell the same as aforesaid, and appropriate the Proceeds thereof to the  
Payment of my Just debts, and that they a the Servars or Servars of them  
shall have full and ample Power to Perform the said trust and good and lawfull  
deeds and other Lawfull conveyances to make and execute to the Purchaser thereof  
as fully as I could do the same myself.

Secondly. It is my will and desire that my executors hereinafter named  
Shall have the Possession and use of my real and Personal estate not  
herein before devized or Bequeathed to my wife Janet Stade to my son  
Alfred Stade and so much of the Property Bequeathed to Thomas B Stade in  
trust for Mary <sup>my</sup> Henderson as is now in the Possession of the said Mary Ann  
Henderson for the Term of three years from the first day of January next  
and that they appropriate the Proceeds and Profits thereon arising to the  
Payment of my Just debts —

Thirdly. I give and devize to my wife Janet Stade the Manner Plantation  
whereon I now live and all the Lands thereto Belonging or adjoining to the  
all of the Appertances thereto a in any wise appertaining also the Lands  
in Cowhouse Islands which I Purchased of Edward Byrd together with all  
the Lands which I own Bounded as follows — Beginning on Cowhouse Creek in  
mouth of the first Branch above the Bridg, Running along and with the  
said Branch to Byrd's Causway thence a straight line to a Bowdowm  
Benjamin Gaines corner, also including the Land I hold by grant from  
the State as well as by deed from Vinegar Stade last used to have

and to hold the said Lands to her the said Janet Stade for and during her natural  
life —

Fourthly. I give and Bequeath to my wife Janet Stade during her natural life the following  
negroes to wit Sam, Stephen, Andy, Jack, gather, Moses, Don, Luke, esbene, Chan  
Big, Vney, Abby, Jard & Charles.

Fifthly. I give and Bequeath to my wife Janet Stade all my Household & Kitchen  
furniture of Every Description and all the Farming utensils Belonging to the Manner  
Plantation also the carriage & Harness thereto Belonging carriage Harnes two Miles are  
to be of iron & cast, one Pair of Harnes which have cows and calves ten Geese & Lambs  
ten hens and Pigs to be chosen by her out of my Stock and sufficient quantity of provision for her family  
and Stock for one year next following my death — also aige girl shown to her her executors & administrators

Sixtly. I give and devize unto my son Alfred Stade my Cowhouse Plantation with the Lands  
and appertances thereto Belonging, also one Pair or Parcell of Land lying on Gentry's Passow, Beginning  
at a typp standing on Cowhouse Creek at the Beaver hole, opposite Spars corner thence a Direct  
course to Spars upper corner in the Back line including all the Land that I own Between said  
Spars and Cowhouse lines, also the undivided Three part of an half acre of Land at the mouth of  
Shawkey gut, also all the lots Town in the town of Williamson except those Mortgaged to me by  
John Smithson, all which Lands and every Part and Parcel thereof with their appertances I give  
and devize to my said son Alfred Stade his heirs and spouzes forever —

Seventhly. I give and Bequeath unto my son Alfred Stade his executors and Administrators the  
following negroes to wit Solomon, Little Stephen, yellow George, George son of Charley, Charley  
Aley, Jack, Sophia, and Tom.

Eighthly. I give and Bequeath to Thomas B Stade his executors administrators the following  
negroes to wit Sampson, Dick, Harry, Harriet and her child Madison, Pitt, Sophronia, and  
Eliza, notwithstanding in Special trust and confidence that he the said Thomas B Stade his  
executors and Administrators will Permit my Daughter Mary Ann Henderson to Retain, hold  
use and enjoy the said negroes and their increase during her natural life, and after her death  
will divide the same equally Between the Children of the said Mary Ann, that may be  
living at her death and convey the same by deed of Bargain and Sale or other valid conveyance  
to the said Children so as to vest the absolute title to said negroes and their increase in the  
said Children.

Ninthly. It is my will and desire that all the Residue of my negroes, not before disposed of  
shall at the expiration of three years from the first of January next be equally divided between  
my children, Thomas B Stade, James B Stade, Elizabeth Stade, and William Stade, and it is  
further my will and desire that after the death of my wife, Janet Stade, all the negroes and  
divided Between my children Mary Ann Henderson, Thomas B Stade, James B Stade, William  
Stade & Elizabeth Stade.

Tenthly. It is my will and desire that the residue of my real estate, not herein before  
devized (Except the Residuary in the Manner Plantation) shall be equally divide Between  
my children Thomas B Stade, James B Stade, Elizabeth Stade and William Stade  
and I give and devize the said Lands to my said Children their heirs and  
spouzes forever.

102) I hereby give and devise to my son William Slade his heirs and assigns the remainder in the Wimber Plantation devised to my wife Anne Slade for life - to have and to hold the same same after the death of my wife Anne to her heirs and assigns forever.

I hereby nominate constitute and appoint my sons Alfred M Slade, Thomas B Slade, James B Slade and my worthy friend Henry B Hunter executors of this my last will and Testament - in Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this Thirtieth of August 1824

by me executed do now make the following Addendum which such and done  
Shall be taken as a part thereof and which is intended not to alter, modify or change  
any Part thereof except that clause which is intended to be altered hereby -

It is my will and desire that the Lands which are divided in the tenth clause  
of the will above to be Equally divided Between my Children, Thomas B Slade,  
James B Slade, Elizabeth Slade and William Slade, that the said lands be  
Equally divided Between my sons Thomas B Slade, James B Slade, and William  
Slade and they in consideration thereof pay to my Daughter Elizabeth Slade one  
Thousand Dollars each by two Annual Instalments from the first day of January  
one Thousand Eight Hundred and twenty Eight with interest from the said first day  
of January 1828 - In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal  
this 30th August 1824

of sound mind and memory thanks be given to god for the same  
calling to mind that it is appointed for all men to do make  
and execute this my last will and Testament in form following  
to wit -

I give unto my loving wife Sarah Peat Sixty acres of Land  
including the House and plantation where we live during  
her natural life also one Bed and furniture also one Horse

I give unto my son Andrew Peat five dollars Current  
Money to be paid out of my Estate

I give unto my Son Isaac Peat twenty shillings and one Shilling  
I give unto my son Miles Peat twenty shillings and one Shilling Pea

I give unto my Son George Peat ten dollars Current money  
to be paid out of my Estate

I give unto my Son Abel Peat the Plantation that at  
present of Edward Griffis Called the Warren Place supposed to be  
fifty acres

I give unto my son David Peat one hundred and forty six acres of  
Land lying on the Round River

I give unto my son George Peat ten dollars Current money  
to be paid out of my Estate

I give unto my Daughter Mary Peat fifty dollars Current money  
to be paid out of my Estate

I give unto my Daughter Rachel Peat fifty dollars Current  
money to be paid out of my Estate

I give unto my Daughter Mary Peat fifty dollars to be paid  
out of my Estate

I give unto Mary Peat Rachel Peat and Henry Pea  
one Bed and furniture each

I hereby constitute and appoint my son Abel Peat  
Executor of this my last will and testament disannulling and  
making void every other former will & Testament by me at  
any time before Ratifying this and no other to be my last  
this the 25<sup>th</sup> of December 1822
