

394) In the name of God amen I John Jones of the State of North Carolina & Chatham County of Chatham being weak in body but of sound mind & memory thanks be given unto God for the same but calling to mind that it is appointed for all men once to die do make & bequeath this my last will & Testament in form following to wit

My first wish is that all my Just debt be paid out of my State

I am & Give & bequeath unto my son Robert Jones the Land
& Plantation whereon I resided with improvements, also my
part of my Water Grist Mill to be delivered him when he arrives to
lawful age to him & his heirs forever

Then I gave & bequeathed unto my son Thomas Jones one small Tract of
land, I purchased of John Bryan also one Harvard house of Land
I purchased of John Perry formerly being had to the said to him
& his heirs forever

Item I give unto my son Daniel Fones Twenty Shillings of current money to be paid out of my estate

Item I give unto my Daughter Peninah Tral Twenty Shillings current money to be paid out of my estate

Sum I give unto my Daughter Hannah Toms Twenty Shillings to
be paid out of my Estate

Item I give unto my Daughter Mary Jones Twenty Shillings current money to be paid out of my estate

Then I give unto my Daughter Mary, Four Twenty Shillings current
money to be paid out of my estate

Item I give unto my Daughter Deborah Twenty Shillings of current money to be paid out of my estate

That I give & bequeath all the Rest & Residue of my estate both Real & Personal to my son Thomas Jones to dispose of among my beloved heirs in such time & in such a manner as he shall think most proper for their use & benefit

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 Lastly I constitute & appoint my son Thomas Stone Executor
 to this my last will & Testament fully Resolving, desiring,
 & making void every other form Will or Testament by me at any
 time made Ratifying this and no other to be my last This 14th
 Day of December 1792.

Then I gave & begged the water my son Joshua Price one Hamam & twenty pieces
of Lead being where the Price formerly lived on one Box, one ~~small~~ small
table one Jug one dish one pot one Negro boy by the name of Sharpen
unto him & his heirs forever.

Time I give ane bezuquether unto my Daughter Elizabeth Price one huger
Gul by the name of hire one Rod & Hamilton one dish, Bafon one pair
1 Linning whur & one Wooling Whur, gallon Saff unto hir & hir hand
& amir

I give and bequeath unto my four children that is to say
 Reuben Price William Price Sophia Price & Elizabeth Price four parts
 of house all my stock of cattle and all my stock of sheep to be equally
 divided between the four children unto them & their heirs forever

I give unto my son Reuben Price one negro woman by the
 name of Amy & her increase from this time to go back to my son
 children as far as till she has six children the said named that
 leave this increase to is John Price My Price Dew Price William
 Price Sara Harrod Thurbay Gals the said increase to be equally divided
 between the said six children to them and their heirs forever

I give unto my son John Price five shillings sterling to him
 & his heirs forever

I give unto my son Wm Price five shillings sterling to him
 & his heirs forever

I give and bequeath unto my son Dew Price five shillings sterling
 unto him & his heirs forever

I give & bequeath unto my son Daughter Sara Harrod five shillings
 unto her & her heirs forever

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Thurbay Gals five shillings
 sterling unto her & her heirs forever

I do appoint John Price Reuben Price Executors to this will
 Witness hereunto set I set my hand & Seal Oct^r 11th day 1800

 Mathew County being weak of Body but of perfect mind &
 memory thanks be to the Almighty for the same and knowing
 that it is appointed for all men to die do make and ordain
 this my last will & Testament in manner and form following

I send & bequeath unto my wife Martha Price for life time the
 sea plantation where I formerly lived on and then I cross one by
 the name of Pat one by the name of Hope one by the name of
 Willis and every other thing that I possess beside what I will unto
 my six children

I give and bequeath unto my son John Price to him and his heirs forever
 one hundred and seventy four of Land where I now live on after my wife
 death and half the Orchard at my death and the three hundred acres
 of Cornet land to be equally divided between my three sons that is to
 say Thomas Price William Price and John Price to them and their heirs
 forever

I give and bequeath unto my three sons after my wife death one still
 that is to say Thomas Price William Price & John Price to them and
 their heirs forever

I send and bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Price one negro woman
 named Pat and her increase from this date her lifetime and to her heirs
 of said Ann Price should die without lawful heirs of her Body or have
 heirs and they die before they come to age the said negro woman named
 Pat and her increase from this date to be equally divided between my
 three sons Thomas Price William Price & John Price unto them and
 their heirs forever

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Price unto her and her
 heirs forever one Bed and furniture one linen to her
