most blessed and glorious time of my Desolution then to take me to himself unto
that peace and rest and incomparable felicity which he has prepared for all those
that love and fear his holy Name Amens I give my body to the earth from
whence to ~~ever~~ gather in full appearance of its Resurrection from thence at the last
day as for my Burial I desire it may be decent without a state at the discretion
of my executors hereafter named who I doubt not will manage it with all due respect
prudence as to my worldly estate I will and Positively ordain that all my debts
be paid —

Item — I give and Bequeath to my dear father Samuel Ray my negro gal falls
to him forever also I bind my other my four negroes to my son Sarah
lesser & Samuel to him During his naturals life also one slave about
two years old to him forever —

Item I give and Bequeath after the Decease of my father to my Sister Elizabeth Ray
my three negroes Mr. Sarah & Samuel —

Item I give and Bequeath to James Johnson my negro boy leave to him and
his heirs lawfully Begotten forever —

Item I give and Bequeath to my Brother Stephen Ray the sum of five shillings
to be paid by my executors

Item I give and Bequeath my Sister Sarah Ray the sum of five shillings to be
paid by my executors —

I hereby nominate and appoint and make choice of Hardy Migele to witness
to this my last will and testament in testimony whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal this twentieth day of January one thousand eight hundred
and two signed sealed and Delivered in the presence of us

Carolina and County of Martin being of sound & perfect mind and memory
Blessed be God the calling to mind that it is appointed for all men sometime
to make and ordain this to be my last Will & Testament in manner and form
as follows (viz) First I recommend my soul to the hands of that God that
first gave it and my body to be buried in a decent Christian like manner
at the Discretion of my Executress herein after mentioned and as touching what
worldly goods it has pleased God to bless me with I give & dispose of in the
following form and manner to wit Item It is my will and desire that

~~a sufficient quantity of my property to my wife and my slave property be sold
to pay my just debts at the Discretion of my Executress~~

Item It is my will & desire that my son John and Daughter Maria Pearce
have sufficient schooling out of my Estate clear of my charges for Schooling
or Board — Item I send to my beloved wife Phoeby Pearce during her
Widowhood eight Negroes to wit Harry Charles Lucy Henry Eddy Temp Lucy
& Lucy I also lend to my beloved wife half the land wherein I now live
beginning at the mouth of the spring branch thence running up
the branch to the head thereof thence a straight line to a branch
that empties into Shepherds marsh also all my land known by the name
of the Tobacco Island also one Island known by the name of man
Island I also lend to my beloved wife three Cows & Calves three year
& Lambs Four feather beds two Steads and Furniture one Walnut
Table one Small folding one large Table one Desk one base
half dozen horses & forks four iron & gear one flea Wheel Two
Wool Wheel two Stone Sugs one Butter Pot flat Irons on one
hand Irons two Pails two Tubs three Stands one pair small ^{and} ~~big~~
two Weeding hoes two grubbing hoes two Plough hoes Stock &
Horses two acres iron Wedges ground Stone one Yoke of Steers
& Cart one horse & one mare side Saddle Maiden Chair &
Gear one dozen Setting Chairs and as much Kitchen Furniture
as will be necessary for her & one Blue Chest —

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Phoeby Pearce four cows
& pigs three thousand weight of back Eighty Barrels of Corn Twenty
Bushells of Wheat Thirty five weight of coffee Twenty five weight
of sugar and two steers for her years provision and all the bedding flea
Item I give & Bequeath unto my Son wife Pearce half my Land on flat swamp
that will apprise for Duds from Neighbors Board and Nathan Roberts
