First of all I Will that all my Just debts be lawfully paid -

I will leave to my Negro woman named Lucy and one Negro girl named Lydia one feather bed, Bratton and furniture and one hand mill only. Reserving the use of said legacy to Esther Allen Mother of Said Bradford & Ted during her Natural life.

Item I will and Bequeath to my Niece Esther Allen one Riding chair & Chair  
Item I will and Bequeath to my Niece Harriet Swinson one Negro girls piano & my  
one feather bed bedstead and furniture one Large Walnut Table with all and  
singular the furniture Belonging to my Bequests and one large pine chest but  
I should said Harriet size without告诉 her Begeton of her body my will  
and desire is that the above named Legacy be equally Between my Nieces  
Esther Allen and my Nephew Gabriel Swinson

I will bequeath to my Nephew Gabriel Swinson one Desk one feather  
Box Bedstead and furniture one Large chest with Lock & Key one case  
with seven Bottles all my cloth now on the ground with all my farming utensils  
with all the vendees of my house and Kitchen furniture and one Saddle and one  
Negro woman Name Betty but should said Gabriel die without lawful heir  
Begetter of his Body my will are Done & that his legacy be equally divided  
Between my two Nieces Esther Allen & Harriet Swinson.

Item I will and Bequeath to my Nephew Samuel Sonnelson son of Nehemiah  
Sonnelson said one walnut Table one feather bed bedding and furniture  
But if said Samuel Should die without Lasefull here Bequeath all his  
Body my will and desire is that his Legacy be divided in the

Same Manner as aforementioned Legacies or  
And I hereby make and declare to appoint my truly friend William Stewart executor  
of this my last will and testament Decanting and Revoking all other wills testaments  
and Bequests by me made Rattifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will

In the Name of God Amen I John Reddick son<sup>t</sup> of the county of Martin in the State of North Carolina being well in health and of sound disposing mind and memory and calling to mind the Mortality of Mankind etc knowing it is Appertainant for all men once to die to make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following first and Principally I Recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it and my body to be Buried in a decent Christian like manner at the Discretion of my ex<sup>t</sup> first friends that all my just debts and funeral charges be paid and satisfied out of my estate I Give to my beloved wife Charity Reddick the land and Plantation wherein I now live during her natural life or widowhood and after her death a Marriage I give and bequeath the abovesaid land and Plantation to my son George W Reddick and my heirs of him and he the said George W Reddick is to have the new ground fields and that part of the land which he arrives to the age of twenty one years and if my son George W Reddick should die leaving no issue lawfully begotten of his body then my son James Reddick to have the Land to him and their heirs and assigns forever.

I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Marinas Riddick my negro girl Kate  
and my wife Charity Riddick to have the care and use of the said negro girl  
KATE till Marinas arrive to the age of twenty one years and if she should die  
before that time for KATE to be hired out but to go and stay with Marinas  
till that time to her her heirs and assigns forever.

Then I gave and Bequeath to my Daughter Piggy Radick my negro girl Bed one  
betherized Bed Sheets and furniture and one cow and calf to her her heirs and  
assigns forever.

I give and Bequeath my Negro woman Anny and her Increase to be Equally  
Divided Between my Daughter Ann Dugger and my Daughter Liza Dugger  
and my Son James Reddick and my Son George W Reddick when my Son  
George W Reddick comes to the age of twenty one years and for

99 Mr Dugger and wife Dugger have the use and care of said negro family till  
that time and if either James or George should die leaving no lawfull issue of their  
Bodies then the survivor & survivor of them to have the negroes to them and their heirs  
and assigns forever - I give and Bequeath to my son James Reddick one feather bed  
and Bedstead and furniture to him and his heirs and assigns forever - I give and  
Bequeath to my wife Charity Reddick one chair named Bed and Bedstead and the shades  
and one feather bed bedstead and furniture and my Stock Hogs and cattle and horses and  
that for the use of the family to her heirs and assigns forever - It is my will & desire that  
my Pine wood land and young more be sold to pay debts and other charges and that my  
kids have no late but sell at private sale Land and More - It is also my will and  
desire that my son George W. Reddick and my Daughter Maria Reddick have good sufficient  
Schooling out of the price of the Land and More and of any left to be Equally divided  
Between all my children and if not enough to sell at private sale such things  
as you may think can be best shared out of the last but property and cattle  
all the Remaining part of my Estate within and without exec I leave to my wife  
her Natural life or widowhood and after her Death or marriage to be equally  
Divided Between all my children - Lastly I constitute and appoint my son James  
Reddick and my son in law William Dugger ex<sup>t</sup> to this my last will and  
testament hereby Revising and Disanulling all former wills by me made and  
Ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and testiment  
or witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 20<sup>th</sup> day of February 1837

memory (Helped by God) do this the 8<sup>th</sup> day of November in the  
Year of our Lord 1833 make & publish this my Last will  
& testament in manner following, that is to say  
First, I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth  
Spruill one negro girl by the name of Lucy which I  
her one negro boy by the name of Stephen to be delivered when I  
print paper together with what I have given her hertofore

which consist in household furniture and the profits arising from  
the sale of a negro woman which she or husband has already granted  
to her & her heirs forever. Secondly, I give and bequeath unto my daughter  
Mary Ann Spruill one negro woman by the name of Charity and her  
increase which I have had & her one negro girl by the name of Lydia  
one negro boy by the name of Solomon Lydia & Solomon to be delivered  
when I shall print together with what I have given her hertofore to  
her her heirs forever Thirdly, I give and bequeath to my daughter  
Elizabeth Spruill one negro woman by the name of Grace and all her increase  
one negro girl by the name of Anna which are loaned to her as the others are  
Elizabeth & Anna also I give unto my daughter Gilpha Spruill fifty  
dollars in money to be raised out of my estate at my death to her and  
her heirs forever together with what I have given her hertofore Fourthly  
I give unto my son Wm E. Ballard my manor plantation that I now  
live on together with all the Land I am seized & titled of one negro man  
by the name of Benjamin one negro woman by the name Newford and all  
her increase one negro boy by the name of George and feather bed  
& furniture &c. Cows & cattle to him & his heirs forever It is also  
my will & desire that my son Wm E. Ballard have a negro boy by  
the name of Isaac until my three daughters (viz) Elizabeth Spruill Mary  
the name of Isaac until my three daughters (viz) Elizabeth Spruill Mary  
Ann Spruill, & Gilpha Spruill they and their husbands or heirs should  
convey to him the said William E. Ballard a right or title in fee to  
the Land I conveyed to my son James E. Ballard before his death  
containing by estimation one hundred and fifty acres bounded to the  
right and left of them or their heirs among his right to said  
they and each of them or their heirs otherwise to  
have the above named negro boy Isaac  
or their heirs should have the above named negro boy Isaac  
to be equally divided between them or their heirs otherwise to  
remain William E. Ballard Jr. Fifthly - It is my will & desire  
after all my just debts are paid that the remainder of my  
estate which is not already given away be equally divided between  
my four children (viz) Elizabeth Spruill, Mary Ann Spruill, Gilpha  
Spruill & William E. Ballard - And I do hereby make &  
ordain my worthy friend William E. Ballard & Joseph N. Ballard ex<sup>t</sup>  
of this my last will & testament in witness whereof I the s<sup>r</sup> Elisha Ballard  
have to this my last will & testament set my hand & seal the  
day & year above written signed, seal Published & declared by the s<sup>r</sup>
