 Wife all the house hold Furniture & every kind of whatsover that belong
 to her before I married her
 And I Give and bequeath to my son Samuel Wiggins my Horse called
 Dolphin the sum of Samuel Wiggins paying to my son Wm Wiggins
 five pounds piece of Gold to my son Samuel Wiggins one Black Walnut
 Bedstead
 And I Give and bequeath to my son B. Baker Wiggins one Silver
 kettle sword & money buckle
 And I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Jones a five Silver
 Dollars to be Equally divided between her five Children
 And I Give and bequeath the remainder of my whole Estate of every kind
 whatsoever that is not herein before Mentioned or Given in legacies
 to be Equally Divided between my two sons Samuel Wiggins & B. Baker
 Wiggins and their heirs or Assigns share & share alike
 And Lastly I nominate constitute and Appoint my two sons
 Samuel Wiggins and Blake Baker Wiggins Executors to this my last
 Will and Testament, hereby revoking & disannulling all other
 Wills by me heretofore by me made in whatso manner I have
 heretofore by my hand and seal this 16th Day of December 1783.

126. In the Name of God Amen I Love Life Saviour of Mankind
 & State of North Carolina being of sound & perfect mind and memory
 do hereby do this Testator the Day of September 1783 in the
 Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty three make
 Publish this my last Will & Testament in Manner following
 That is to say
 I Give and bequeath unto William Sauridge my son the tract
 of Land & Plantations whereon I now live being more than one Hundred & Twenty
 Acres more or less to him and to his heirs for ever also one Case of
 bottles I Give and bequeath unto Wm Sauridge my son one small
 Gun and one pair of silver shoe buckles two pair of silver knee buckles
 one silver stick (buckle one silver chest and one Table two plate dishes
 one large plate basin one small B. one half dozen plate plates and one
 half dozen spoons & one Pocket after the death or Marriage of my Wife
 to him and to his heirs for ever and one half of my flock of sheep
 And I Give and bequeath unto Mary Sauridge my well beloved Wife
 one hunting saddle & Bridle one Linen Wheel one wooden Wheel
 and Cards two Rustle Pavers Eight Plate plates one painted
 Chest one further Bed & Furniture called her own two something boxes
 two Lamb Churn to her and to her heirs for ever and one fork and one
 half of my flock of sheep and one plate dish
 And I bequeath Mary Sauridge my well beloved Wife one third part
 of the Land & Plantations whereon I now or last lived during her
 Natural life and the third of my stock of cattle and hogs during
 her Widowhood and after the Marriage of my Wife I Give and bequeath
 unto her one third part of the Cattle and Hogs
 And I further my Will & devise that my Wives Musthills and such
 other cattle and hogs best be shared should be sold for money to
 purchase a Negro Girl for my son William Sauridge which said Negro
 Girl I Give and bequeath unto my son William Sauridge to
 him and to his heirs for ever excepting the use of said Girl which I Give
 unto my Wife during her Widowhood
 And I further constitute and Appoint my two brothers William Sauridge
 & Robert Sauridge & my friend Nathan Mayo Executors to this my last Will
 & Testament in whatso manner I have herein to set my hand & affix
 my seal this day & year above Written
