I Jonathan Cherry of the State of North Carolina in the County of Martin, a single Person being  
of sound mind & memory thanks be to God for the same, but calling to mind the mortality  
of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this  
my last will and Testament that is to say

Principally and first of all I give and Recommend my soul into the hand of God that gave it  
and for my Body I Recommend it to the earth to be buried in a Christian like decent manner  
at the Direction of my executors nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall  
receive the same again by the mighty Power of God - and as touching such worldly estate  
wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I give and Dispose in the same  
manner from following that is to say

- my will and Desire is that all my Just Debts should be paid out of my estate  
then I give unto my son John Cherry my Large Bible -  
then I give unto my Daughter Elizabeth Cherry one Feather bed & furniture to her & her heirs -  
then I give unto my Daughter Jane Cherry one Feather bed & furniture to her & her heirs -  
then I give unto my Daughter Ester Cherry one Feather bed & furniture to her & her heirs -  
then I give unto my grandsons Frederick Cherry and William Cherry the Land and Plantation  
whereon I now live to be equally divided between them and the Land thereunto  
belonging to them and their heirs forever -  
then I give unto my grand Daughter Estey Luster one Feather bed & furniture to her and  
her heirs forever -

also my will & Desire is that all the Remainder of my estate that I have not  
already given away should be equally divided between all my Daughters whose  
Names follows. Sarah Ann Elizabeth Jane & Estey

- then I do appoint nominate and ordain my son John Cherry and my Brother Joel Cherry  
executors to this my last will and Testament - I hereby Disclaim Revolve &  
Disannul all other wills by me made Testimony & Confirming this  
and no other to be my last will and Testament in witness whereof my hand and seal  
the day and year first above written signed sealed Published Recommended &  
Declared by me to be my last will & Testament in the Presence of us

In the Name of God Amen - I John Watts of Martin County being in Health  
through sound Mind & Memory I make this my last will and Testament as follows -  
then I give to my son the five Hundred Dollars -

- It is my wish & Desire that my Land I Purchas'd of John D. Williams should be sold and the  
money after paying of my Debts to be equally Divided between my Mother & Brothers -  
then I bequeath to my Mother her Lifetime my negro man Robbin also I bequeath to my Mother her Lifetime  
my Part of the Land that is uninclosed between me and my Brothers -  
I appoint Lewis & Williams executors to this my last will and Testament - this the fourth  
Day of October 1800 signed sealed and acknowledged before us

In the Name of God Amen I Thomas Garrett of the State of North Carolina Martin County: Fama being very  
sick & weak in Body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be given unto God calling to mind the mortality  
of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will  
and Testament that is to say Principally and first of all I give & Recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty  
God that gave it & my Body I Recommend to the earth to be buried in a Decent Christian Burial at the  
Direction of my executors nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again  
by the mighty Power of God - and as touching such worldly estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me  
in this life I give & Dispose of the same in the following manner and form -

First of all I bequeath unto my wife Elizabeth Garrett the one third of my Land during her  
Natural Life Privately to Possess - I give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Sophie Martin one Dollar -  
I give unto my Daughter Nancy Garrett one Dollar - two thirds of my Land I give to my Daughters  
Mary Bowen & Thomas Martin my grand Child to be equally Divided between them together  
with one Bed Bedstead & furniture one chest & one Table to be equally Divided between  
them - I give unto my wife one Bed Bedstead & furniture and one chest and the one  
third Part of my Moveable Property - the other two thirds of my Moveable Property to be equally  
Divided between Mary Bowen & Thomas Martin - and the third of my Land which I have  
bequeath to my wife is at her Decease to be equally Divided between Mary Bowen and  
Thomas Martin all that I have given to Thomas Martin is to be placed in the hands  
of Langley Phipps untill he shall arrive to twenty one years of age I ordain & appoint  
Langley Phipps & William Brogden executors to this my last will & Testament in witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 17<sup>th</sup> day of April one thousand eight Hundred  
and Seventeen - signed sealed & Delivered in the Presence of us
