 Christian Reddick & my Son Noah Reddick One Negro Girl named Eliza with
 her Increase to Equally Divided between them on the 25 Day of June in the Year
 one thousand seven hundred & Ninety five & if either of my said Daughters should
 die or Christian should die or my Son Noah before such Division it is my
 Will that the Survivors or Survivors of them three have the said Negro Girl &
 her Increase to them their heirs & assigns for ever
 It is my Will & devise that my Negro Man named Par. Henry & Cash. White
 be Equally Divided between all my Living Children at the Death or Marriage
 of my Wife and that my said Wife have the Use of the said Negroes during
 her Natural Life & Widowhood
 I Give & devise that my Son Noah have three years schooling and that
 my other Sons have Good & sufficient schooling at the Discretion of my Executors
 Paid out of my Estate
 I Give & devise that my sons if they should settle themselves
 all have the Liberty of my Will to still their own Lives
 I Give & bequeath to each of my four Sons the Use of their
 heirs & assigns for ever
 I Give & bequeath to my Son John Reddick My Sons Miller Reddick & my
 Son Thomas Reddick each of them a Gun to them their heirs & assigns for ever
 It is my Will & devise that my Daughter Charity Reddick have the Use of my
 Negro Girl Eliza until the Division of the said Negro as before mentioned &
 that she have the Care of her Sister Christian
 I do hereby constitute and Appoint my beloved Son John Reddick & beloved
 Son Simon Daniel sole Executors to this my Last Will & Testament
 hereby revoking & annulling all former Wills by me made & Statutory
 and confirming this & no other to be my Last Will & Testament In Witness Whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 25 Day of June 1783
