The last Will and Testament of Levi Pagan at present of the County of Warren & State of North Carolina I give to my dear Fabius Payette Pagan my negro by bequest without being liable to any part of my debts or encumbrances of any kind -

all the rest of my property that I may own at my death, and which I receive in right of my wife Hannah, I give to my wife Hannah, my son Stephen and Fabius Payette Pagan to be equally divided between them -

All the rest and residue of my Estate of what nature, description or kind soever, I give to my son Franklin Pagan he paying one fourth part of my debts, the other three fourths to be paid by my other legatees -

I appoint my son Franklin P. Pagan Guardian of my son Fabius P. Pagan -

I nominate and appoint my sons Franklin P. Pagan and Stephen Pagan Executors of this my last will and testament, with full power and authority to settle the concerns of my Estate in any way that they may think proper by selling any part of my property (except negro by bequest) at public or private sale for Cash or in a credit as well as in all other respects touching or concerning the settlement of my Estate -
