and State of N Carolina being of perfect mind and memory thank
be to God for the same. Knowing that it is appointed for all men
to die do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament to wit

Item 1st In the first place do recommend my soul to Almighty
God who gave it and my body to be committed to the mother earth

Item 2nd It is my Will and desire that all my just debts
be paid and the balance of my property that it has pleased God
to bless me with I give and dispose of in manner and form following

Item 3rd I send unto my Daughter Catherine Hyman one
Negro man by the name of Willis during her life and after her
death I give the said Negro man Willis to her children -

Item 4th I give unto my Son Turner Bryan two Hundred
Dollars to him and his Heirs forever -

Item 5th I give unto my Son Liles Bryan one feather Bed
and furniture to him and his Heirs forever -

Item 6th I give unto the Heirs of my son William Bryan
two Hundred and fifty Dollars to them and their Heirs forever -

Item 7th I give unto my Son John Bryan the whole of my
Lands wherein I now live containing One Thousand and Sixty Acres
by estimation be the same more or less also my Brandy still and its
contents and my right in the land called the Harrell place to
him and his Heirs forever -

Item 8th I give unto my Grand Daughter Tally Hyman Daughter
of Lewis & Hyman ten Dollars to her and her Heirs forever -

Item 9th I send unto my Daughter Mary P. Mayo one Tract of Land
whereon she now lives containing Eighty Acres be the same more or less

and after her death I give the said Land to her children to them
and their Heirs forever - Also I send unto my Daughter Mary Mayo
one Negro girl named Hannah and her increase during her life and
after her death I give the said Negro and increase of any to her Children
to them and their Heirs forever -

Item 10th It is my Will that the balance of my property not given
in this my last will be equally divided between Catherine Hyman
Turner Bryan - Liles Bryan - John Bryan - and Mary P. Mayo -

I hereby appoint my son John Bryan my Executor to this my last
Will and Testament in writing whereof I do herein set my hand
and affix my seal this 24th of December in the year of our Lord
one thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty nine.
