

16 In the name of God whom I Stephen Hagan being in good health and of sound mind and memory thanks be to almighty God for the same but being to mend the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed unto all men once to die on the 24 day of December 1813 made and publish this my last Will and Testament Revokable and first of all I recommend my soul into the hands of almighty God and desire to be buried in a Christian like manner at the direction of my Executors and wishing my worldly Estate when with it shall please God to be given in this like I desire for same following I have I have to my beloved wife Anna Hagan my negro girl Betty and her increase for and during her natural life after her decease I give and bequeath said negro girl Betty and her increase to my daughter Leah Hagan to her if she live for ever in I have unto my beloved wife Anna Hagan my Manor Plantation with the land & tenements adjoining her and during her natural life or widowhood and if she marry again I have her one third part of my Manor Plantation and land adjoining her and during her natural life

I give unto my beloved wife Anna Hagan her choice of my better land of furniture my two slaves named Hans two cows and calves two pigs off two stacks of corn one wooden and one iron saw and two axes and Niggs two barrels of corn in half of my meat two horn pots one large and one small one iron fire bucket or Pan one sheet six shars five bundles of Rata Plantings my bedpost and furniture. I also give unto my well beloved wife one table her bed of bedden two wearing hens one or as in half of my kitchen I give unto my daughter Nancy Stewart one cow and calf I give to each of my daughters Harriet Polly and Leah one leather bed and furniture and one cow and calf I give unto my daughter Sally Collins one hundred dollars to be raised out of the Residue part of my Estate I give unto my grand son Henry Collins County heir dollars to be raised out of the Residue part of my Estate I give unto my four daughters Nancy Stewart Polly & Leah my Negro Girl Henry Rose Peter and Mary to be equally divided among them to them and their heirs forever it is my will and desire that my land on Mchies Creek and all the Rest of my Property to be sold by my Executors and the money arising from such sale after paying my debts my four daughters Sally Collins Nancy Stewart Harriet Hagan Polly Hagan and Leah Hagan and I do hereby appoint my loving wife and my Cousin Levi Hagan Executor and CoExecutor of this my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day and date above written

It is to be under that that the legatee left Stephen Hagan Leg
to Leah Hagan is to operate as further after the death of her mother than give her a Girl slave with that it is to be further understood that a Legatee in Georgia left to Henry Collins is to have as Appointee I still continue my Will be loved wife CoExecutor of Cousin Levi Hagan CoExecutor of this my last Will & Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto cause my hand to be set & seal to be first signed hand in the presence of J. 17 In the name of God I Lydiaa Hasty of Warrick County N. Carolina being in a Low state of health but in perfect mind & memory of North Carolina being in a Low state of health but in perfect mind & memory at this time but feeling to mend the mortality of my body knowing that it is appointed for all men to die as such I make & declare this to be my last will and Testament in manner & form as follows first I recommend my soul into the hands of almighty God he give it and my body to the Earth to be buried at a decent Christian burial at the direction of my Executors and for the better of worldly goods that it has been pleased God for to bless me with in this life I desire in the following manner & form that is to say when the plantation whereon I now live I give and bequeath to my two youngest sons Matthew & Levi Hasty for their lives & if they die I give and bequeath to my eldest daughter Julia Hasty the sum of twenty shillings and no more also I give and bequeath all my Negroes and all the residue of my Estate to be sold and equally divided amongst the residue of my children that is to say Lemima Parthen Peter Hasty & Lucinda Hasty also I do nominate & appoint my two sons Peter Hasty & Levi Hasty to be my true sole & lawful Executors of this my last will & Testament and for Peter Hasty for to be said CoExecutor for his trouble being at a distance this thirteenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twelve said said & delivered in presence of us
