 son to Judy, Charity, with their increase to her and her Children & heirs
 one fourth Bed & Furniture
 I then give to my Daughter Mary Spaine two Cows & Calves I further
 the following Negroes to my D. Daughter David, Pety, Edy, Wilks, Lawrence
 Daskin, & Co, son to Lawrence, Ned, son to Pety with their increase to her
 and her heirs I can stipulate and Appoint, my two Sons Jesse Moore & James
 Moore Executors to this my last Will and Testament, revoking and disannulling
 all others heretofore by me made In Witness whereof I have set my
 hand & seal this 18th day of September 1795

 Testament that is to say principally and first of all I give and Recommend
 my Soul into the hands of Almighty God that have it and my
 Body I Recommend to the Earth to be buried in decent Christian
 burial at the Discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at
 the General Connection I shall Receive the same by the mighty
 power of God And as Touching such worldly Estate as is hath pleased
 God to bless me with in this life - I Give and Dispose of the same in
 following manner and form that is to say first that all my just
 debts be paid I give to my beloved Son Joseph Jones five head of Cattle
 to wit two Cows two two year Olds & one yearling one horse one
 bed and Furniture two Mares one or more and one yearling one

 two Cows & yearling & one two year Old Mare one bed & one bedstead where
 I Give to my beloved Daughter Polly Jones two Cows & yearlings I give

 Wheel fire brick & all my working tools and at her Death I give the
 Bed & one Wheel to my Daughter Polly and my Desire is that all
 the Residue of my Property be sold at Public Auction six months Credit
 with Note and Security and I do hereby constitute & appoint my trusty
 friends Joseph Jones Junr & John Stewart Executors of this my last will
 and Testament and I do hereby revoke & annul all & every other will
 I have made & executed by me in any wise before or after this writing
 & Confirming this and no other to be my last will & Testament in writing
 Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 18th day of February

gether with all my house hold Furniture as long as she liveth

and the said stock I have any more I mean to equally divide among
my children that living at that time I then give and

bequeath to my well beloved Son Benjamin Harrison
one hundred & twenty acres of land out of this Survey where

I now live lying up the swamp joining Old man Edwards Cooper's
line and I also give to my Son Benjamin Harrison one acre of

land with all the low swampy land lying on the
and likewise give to my son Benjamin Harrison fifty acres

of land lying on the North Side of the Devils fire I give and
bequeath unto my son Benjamin Harrison the one half

of my Negro boy named Bob to him and his heirs forever
I then give to my well beloved Son Abigail Harrison the man
