 5th I give unto my Daughter Temperance Boyet three negroes named Solomon, Nancy and
 Rachel two feather beds and furniture also two hundred Dollars.
 6th I give unto my son Arthur Boyet the tract of land on which I live containing three
 hundred and fifty acres more or less two negroes named Bob and Rachel also two
 feather beds and furniture.
 7th the rest of my Property to be sold by my executor and after paying all my just debts
 the rest to be equally divided between my three youngest children namely Matthey
 Temperance and Arthur Boyet.
 NB one of the beds and furniture that I have given to the children of Elizabeth Ballentine
 is in her Possession
 I do nominate and appoint Jordan Matton and William A Brown to execute this my last
 will and testament hoping that they will strictly comply with my request
 in testimony hereof I have writt set my hand and seal this 20th January 1793

 her natural Life and after her Death to be Disposed of as I shall hereafter mention
 Item I Give unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Joyce all my Property of every kind
 whatever in Doors and out Doors &c during of her natural Life.

Item after the Death of my beloved wife Elizabeth Joyce I give and Bequeath to my son
 Amijah Joyce one third part of my Land at the lower end to him and his heirs
 forever.

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son Daniel Joyce after the Death of my beloved wife
 Elizabeth Joyce one third Part of my Land in the Middle so as to include the house
 to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son John Joyce one third part of my Land after
 the Death of his mother at the upper end next to the Swamp to him and his heirs
 forever.

Item I give unto my Daughter Matthea Joyce one feather bed and furniture one cow &
 sell to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and Bequeath to Patsy Joyce my Daughter one Cow and calf and
 feather bed and furniture to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and Bequeath unto Talley Congleton my Daughter one Cow and
 calf and one Bed and furniture and one cow and pigs that she has now in
 Possession to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give unto my Daughter Elizabeth Joyce five Shillings to be carried out of my estate
 to her and her heirs forever.
 Item my will is that all my Debts I have not already given away after the death
 of my beloved wife to be equally Divided Between my three sons and two Daughters that is to
 say Amijah Joyce Daniel Joyce John Joyce Matthea Joyce and Patsy Joyce to them and
 their heirs forever.
 And Lastly I nominate constitute and appoint my worthy friend Lige Cherry and my beloved
 wife Elizabeth Joyce executors to this my last will and testament in witness whereof I Martin
 Joyce do this 20th day of January in the year of our Lord 1793 acknowledge this to be my
 last will and testament in presence of us

 already mentioned to my wellbelov'd son Henry Martin to him and his heirs forever.

Item 3d It is my will and Desire that if my son Henry Martin dies without a Lawfull heir
 for all my Property to be Equally divided among all all my Brothers and Sisters.

I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my Brother John Martin my executor to
 this my last will and testament given under my hand and seal this 1st October in the year of
 our Lord one thousand and Eight hundred and twenty two

 his Body at that time or within one month after his Decence and my wife yet alive I then bequeath to
 my wife again and until death But if my son Benjamin Griffin should live to be of age whether
 having any heirs or not say that the remainder be his and the Balance when the Loan is out for him
 to will and to do and if Benjamin Griffin should die under age and Lawfull heir Begotten of his
