Now I Will & Devise that my just Dues and Funeral Charges be paid & Paid & Satisfied

Then I Give unto my Beloved Wife Elizabeth Cockburn my house and the third of my Plantations During of her Widowhood I Give unto my P. Wife the sum of Five pounds Currency of North Carolina to be Paid Out of my Estate to her

Then I Give unto my Daughter Christian M. Five five Shillings Currency of North Carolina to her & to her heirs for Ever

Then I Give unto my Daughter Mary Carson five Shillings Currency of North Carolina to her and to her heirs forever

Then I Give unto my Son George Cockburn five Shillings Currency of North Carolina to him & to his heirs for Ever

Then I Give unto my Daughter Elizabeth Anderson five Shillings Currency of North Carolina to her and to her heirs for Ever

Then I Give unto my Daughter Ann Anderson five Shillings Currency of North Carolina to her and to her heirs for Ever

Then I Give unto my Son John Cockburn the Land & Plantation Wherewith he Now Lives Being the land on the North Side of the Spring branch and all my Land on the North Side of the flat Swamp to him and to his heirs for Ever

Then I Give unto my Son Francis Cockburn my Dwelling Plantation Wherewith I Now Live and the lands thereto belonging Inasmuch Which I Lent to my Wife and at the End of My Wife's Widowhood the part I Lent unto her I Give unto my Son Francis Cockburn With all the Land from Thence as South East to the Spring Branch and Likewise my Land on the South Side of the flat Swamp to my Son Mary Lane Give to him & to his heirs for Ever

And I also Will & Devise that all the Residue of my Estate Which I have Not Mentioned and Given be equally Divided Between my Wives

And my two Sons John and Francis Cockburn to have Theirs for Ever

I Do Give & Devise and Appoint my Wife and John Cockburn and Francis Cockburn Executors to this my Last will and Testament Working Dismissing & Discharging And all other former Wills Bequeaths by me heretofore made Confirming this and the Other to be my Last Will & Testament in Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal the Day & Date first Mentioned

Then I Give and bequeath to my Dear & beloved brother John Smith two thirds of my part of my Father's Estate that was divided between two thirds of my part of the same by the Name of Rose leaving with John Rose - the other third I bequeath unto my Well beloved Son John Smith the the other third part of my share the third property which I bequeath to my Brother John Smith my Brother Andrew Smith to be Executors to my Last Will & Testament
