of the sale of my perishable property after paying all my just
debts or if equal divided betwixt my Grand children Grace
Smith, John Griffin, William Griffin, Africa Griffin, John
Griffin & Sally Griffin -
- 5th I give my Grandson James Griffin the choice of my
two Cows -

6th I nominate appoint & make my beloved son Nath Griffin
my Executor to this my last will & Testament.
