my land on the south side of the above mentioned line my
negro man Brister & my negro boy Darcy to them & their
heirs forever

Item I give & bequeath unto Mary Cherry the former widow
of my son Willie Brown one dollar to her & her heirs forever

Item I leave unto my daughter Elizabeth Davis all the land
I bought of her husband Henry Davis & my negro boy
Stephen & my negro boy Saml during her natural life and
if the S^r Elizabeth should have any issue of her body
at her death I give the above mentioned land & negroes to
the issue of the S^r Elizabeth & their heirs forever but in
case the S^r Elizabeth should die without any living child
that it should return back to the rest of my living
heirs

not before been mentioned or written away & all the rest of
estate of every kind or nature be sold & after paying all my
Just debts and necessary expenses should together with what is
due me & money that may be found in hand together with
what I have in the hands of Nathaniel Brown be equally
divided amongst the children of my dec^d daughter Phoebe Coult
and the children of my daughter Polly Brown dec^d and
Elizabeth Davis so as for the children of S^r Phoebe to have
one third & the children of S^r Polly one third & Elizabeth Davis
one third to them & their heirs forever

I also nominate & appoint William B. Brown executor to this
my last will & testament whereunto I set my hand & seal
