

If she shall remain a widow for that time and if the Child that she now bears shall live to the age of Twenty one years then my will and desire is that the three above named Negroes shall be the rate and property of the Child and its heirs for ever Also my will and desire is if my Child which my wife Nancy now bears shall die at any time from this and the remaining a widow and desire is that she shall have the value of the above tent Negroes in = during her life or widow hood but at her death or marriage my will is that the above tent Negroes shall be Equally divided among all my Children = Item I give unto my beloved wife Nancy Wheatley my land and plantation where on I now live with all the ^{privileges} thereunto belonging so long as she remains a widow and at my wife Nancy Wheatley's death or marriage I give and bequeath unto the Child that she now bears the above tent Land & plantation where on I now live to that and its heirs for ever And if the said Child shall die without heir my will is that the above tent Land shall be Equally divided among all my Children Item I give unto my Child which my wife Nancy now bears my land and plantation on dead water Creek with all privileges to that and its heirs for ever to be rented out till it is Twenty one years of age Item my will and desire is that my ^{land} plantation where on Joseph J. Caraway now lives shall be sold and the money to be Equally divided among my four Grandsons namely Samuel Hatan Wheatley, and Samuel Joseph Wheatley & William Hattie Wheatley and Samuel Caraway Item my will and desire is that all the rest of my Negroes not before mentioned shall be Equally divided among all my Children Item I give unto my beloved wife Nancy Wheatley my Bedchamber ^{Table} more & my Bedding Chair and Harness to her and her heirs for ever I also give unto my loving wife Nancy Three hundred weight of Pork and Three Barrels of Corn Item my will and desire is that all the rest of my portable Estate shall be sold and the Money Equally divided among my first Children I appoint my Friends Noah Reddicks & John Reddicks John Elly Executors to this my last will and Testament this 10th day of January 1816 Signed and sealed in the presence of us ^{Witnesses} Samuel Wheatley ^{James} ^{James} William Duggan
