

In the name of God amen I Myles Jewell of the County of Johnston in the State of North Carolina being weak in body but of sound and disposing mind and memory and willing to expend the mortals of mankind and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die as made and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following first and principally I recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it and my body to be buried in a decent Christian like manner at the Direction of my Executors Vizt I desire that Just Deeds and general Charges be paid and satisfied out of my Estate
I send to my beloved Wife Maria Jewell the land and plantation where I now live and the land and plantation on the little creek and my Negro man Mops and my Negro girls Sandy and Lemby and all my house hold and kitchen furniture and plantation utensils and all my stock of Cuck and my slave and Cott and all my stock of Hogs & Cattle during her Natural life or so long as she shall see fit and then to return to whom it shall be hereafter given - Item I give and bequeath to my Son Simon I Jewell the land and plantation where I now live and the land and plantation on the little creek the the land and plantation on the little creek he is to receive when he arrives to the age of twenty one year and my young son Leopold one fourth part and heretofore and my hunting gun to him his heirs and assigns forever Item I give and bequeath to my Daughters Betty Jewell Caspa Jewell Polly Jewell and Miley Jewell each of them one fourth part and furniture to them their heirs and assigns forever Item I give and bequeath to my four Daughters ^{My four} Caspa Jewell Polly Jewell and Miley Jewell one hundred acres of land on ~~the~~ ^{the} ~~place~~ ^{place} ~~where~~ ^{where} ~~my~~ ^{my} ~~clothes~~ ^{clothes} ~~tools~~ ^{tools} to be sold and Equally divided between them and my blacksmith tools to be laid out yearly till my son Simon Jewell comes to the age of twenty one year for the use of the family and then to be sold and Equally divided among all my then living Children Item I give and bequeath to my four Daughters Betty Jewell Caspa Jewell Polly Jewell and Miley Jewell my two Negro Negro girls Sandy & Lemby to be Equally divided between them their heirs and assigns forever
Lastly I constitute and appoint John Theodorick Jew and Noah Russell Executors to this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and annulling all former wills by me made and ~~ratifying~~ ^{ratifying} and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament in Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the 30 day of June 1813

19 In the name of God amen I Phereby Asher of the State of North Carolina and County of Johnston this the twentieth day of July in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirteen as make and ordain this my last Will and Testament and first of all I give my soul to God who gave it me and my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like manner at the Direction of my Executors and as touching those worldly goods I have I have God to Bless me with in this world I give Simon and Joseph off in the following manner and form Item I give to John Asher one sixth part of land against Thomas Jewell one sixth part hundred & section also one young man at my death to him and his heirs forever Item I give to Patsy Chappel at my death all the Residue of my Estate Real or Personal both within & without to her and her heirs forever and I select & choose William Biggs Esq as Executor to this my last will & Testament ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will & Testament in Confirmation of which I Phereby Asher have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal the day and date above written
