In the name of God Amen I Nancy Pugh of the
County of Martin & State of North Carolina being of sound mind &
disposing memory do make and ordain this my last Will and
Testament as follows

1st I give to my son John Grey Plant Pugh my maid & set
to him and his heirs forever

2^d I give to my son Thomas Pugh's child if his widow
should have and the sum of Five dollars to that & its heirs forever

3^d It is my Will and desire that the balance of my property should
be sold and equally divided between my three Children Martha
Ann Pettigrew Pugh and John Grey Plant Pugh's to them
and their heirs forever - But it is my wish and desire that
if my son Joseph Pugh should have within the North Carolina
State and that case the property that I have given them should
be equally divided between my daughter Martha & son J. B.
Pugh

I Minimize and approve my friend Asa Papp, Executor to this my
last Will and Testament, resolving all former Wills by me made
or written, whosoever I have set my hand and seal this ^{1st day}
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty six
