In the name of God Amen I Nancy Pugh of the County of Martin & State of North Carolina being of sound mind & disposing memory do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament all follows—
 1st I give to my son John Grey Blunt Pugh my mare & colt to him and his heirs forever
 2nd I give to my son Thomas Pugh his Child if his widow Shakes hand over the sum of Five dollars to that & its heirs forever
 3rd I give my wife and desire that the balance of my property should be sold and equally divided between my three children Martha Ann Pittsickie Joseph and John Grey Blunt Pugh to them and their Heirs forever—But as my wish had desired that if my son Joseph Pugh should return to North Carolina that and that case the property that I have given them should be equally divided between my daughter Martha & son J. B. Pugh—
 I nominate and appoint my friend Mr. R. Pugh Executor to this my last will and Testament making all formalities by me made & witnessed whereof I have set my hand and seal this 1st day in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred & thirty six

 & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make & Ordain this my last will & Testament as follows
 To the first place I do now name my soul to Almighty God who gave it & my body to be buried in a decent Christian manner
 Item 1st It is my will that all my just debts be paid
 Item 2nd I give unto my daughter Louisa A. Hyman one feather
 Bed & Furniture one Cow & Calf One Lamb, One Woolen White
 or Stock of Wool one sheep One Walnut Chest & three dollars in
 Cash to her heirs forever
 Item 3rd I give unto my daughter Elizabeth A. Hyman one feather
 Bed & Furniture one Cow & Calf One Stock of Wool one Sheep & one Lamb
 one Sheep Calf, One Sheep one Cow & Calf & three dollars
 in Cash
 Item 4th I give unto my daughter Elizabeth A. Hyman one feather Bed
 & Furniture one Cow & Calf One Stock of Wool, One sheep, my
 Money & Household dollars in Cash to her heirs forever
 Item 5th I give to my son J. W. Hyman one feather Bed and
 Furniture one Cow & Calf and Stock of Wool, and Sheep & my
 Little Colt & three dollars in Cash to them this their forever
 Item 6th I give to my son Joseph A. Hyman one feather Bed
 & Furniture one Cow and Sheep and Stock of Wool and Chest
 and the money arising from the sale of my big mare and
 four dollars in Cash to them this their forever
 I also give to my two daughters Louisa & Sophia my Egg and
 Hamper
 It is my will also that all the notes of hand that I hold be
 kept an interest till my youngest son Joseph I become of age
 & the same to be equally divided and all other property not
 given to be equally divided between my children except my
 little mare which is for the use of my three daughters
 I also appoint my Brother John Pugh my Executor to
 this my last will and Testament & witness whereof I do
 set my hand and affix my seal this 10th day of Sept.
 in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred & thirty six
