I Noah Perry of the State & County being of sound and perfect mind & memory blessed be to God for this 15th day of August in the year of our Lord 1834 make and publish this my last will & Testament in manner following that is to say first I give unto my wife Milly Perry my land & plantation whereon I now live during her life time or widowhood I lend also to my wife all my stock of every description and together with my negro fellow slaves and Hannah and also my boy Simpy.

Second I give unto my son Noah Perry my tract of Land over the little creek and joining Sonthen Chiddick and others - Thirdly I give unto my son Ridding Perry a tract of Land known by the little Land on the west side of the road and on the east side of the road I give the balance of a tract of Land to my son Noah Perry after the death of my wife or marriage I give unto my son Alfred Perry all my creek land & tenantry has been given to my son Ridding Perry a horse bridle and saddle and cow & calf and bid of furniture Lohm

Wadys has received eighty five dollars and a cow & calf and bid of furniture in part of his wife doing - Robert Lavin has rec^d thirty six dollars and bid and furniture and bid of sheep for his wife - Gravel Wilson has rec^d one bid of furniture in part for his wife - Joseph Biggs has rec^d one bid of furniture in part for his wife I give also to my son Noah Perry my negro boy by the name of Adam and also I give to my son Alfred my negro boy by the name of George I wish for the negroes but to my wife if they do not behave to be hired out I also wish for all the negroes not given nor bid to be hired out as soon as they will bring any thing and after the death of my wife or marriage I want all my property not given away to be equally divided among all my sons I also give unto my son Ridding and

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Noah my blacksmith tools I also wish for my negro and calf and all the hogs can be spared to be sold to pay my just debts and also what corn that can be spared to be sold also - I wish and also lend to my wife all my Land in Beaufort County during her life time or widowhood and after to be equally divided between all my daughters and also I lend unto my wife Milly Perry a tract of Land adjoining Easton Rice and John Perry and after her death or marriage to be equally divided among all my daughters - And I hereby make and ord^r in my friends Ridding Perry and Robert Lavin rec^d of this my last will & Testament in witness whereof I the said Noah Perry have to this my last will & Testament set my hand and seal this day &
