

September Session For 1828—

State of North Carolina. Now all men by their
 Martin County present — That I—
 Samuel Falk of the County & State aforesaid do make
 this my last will and testament. (Says)

I wish all my debts to be paid out of the money due
 me and the parashable part of my estate I wish
 all my property except my lands and the houses & lots
 which I own in the Town of Williamston to be equally
 divided between my wife Nancy Falk my daughter
 Mary Eliza Falk and the child which my wife
 Nancy Falk is now pregnant with. I wish my wife
 Nancy Falk's thirds of my lands to be laid out
 in the following manner, in consideration that she
 the S^d Nancy Falk will relinquish all claims to my
 houses & lots in the Town of Williamston to my
 daughter Mary Eliza Falk, and the child which
 she is now pregnant with:

Beginning at a stone mark or corbett oak stump
 just below the forks of the old Gaskey road the corner
 between me and the Town of Jerusalem Slade Sec.
 running thence along a line of marked stones to a post
 which puts out of the Williamston road near the
 corner of the fence where Alfred Mr Slade formerly
 lived—thence along the S^d path to, opposite the head
 of the Branch near my yard and garden, thence
 along the S^d Branch to the run of the fence which passes
 through my pasture, thence along the S^d run to the Island
 road, thence along the S^d road to, opposite my pasture fence
 in the Barn field, thence along the S^d fence to the Branch
 at the upper end of S^d pasture thence along the right hand
 Branch to a small stream which makes up in this field
 near opposite the upper end of my Island field, thence across
 said field to a Branch at the upper end of the Island field
 thence along the S^d Branch to the creek swamp, thence
 along the creek swamp, to the ~~boundary~~ between me and
 Mary Wheatley thence along the S^d line to the Williamston
 road, thence along the S^d road to the old Gaskey road
 and thence to the cross station—

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which parcel of land I due to my wife Nancy Falk during
 her natural life, as her the S^d Nancy Falk's thirds, in case
 she relinquish her the S^d Nancy Falk's interest to my
 house and lots in the Town of Williamston, to my daughter
 Mary Eliza Falk, and the unborn child which she the S^d
 Nancy Falk is now pregnant with and which the S^d
 piece or parcel of land, at the death of my wife Nancy
 Falk to return to my daughter Mary Eliza Falk &
 the unborn child which my wife Nancy is now pregnant
 with:

I give to my daughter Mary Eliza Falk and the
 unborn child which my wife Nancy is now pregnant with
 all the land which I possess and my house and lots in the
 Town of Williamston except the parcel which I have allotted
 to my wife Nancy Falk during her natural life, and
 at the death of my wife Nancy Falk I also give this
 parcel of land to them the S^d Mary Eliza Falk and the unborn
 child, which my wife Nancy is now pregnant with, to be
 equally divided between them. I do authorize and appoint
 Durham Davis and Thomas Biggs my Executor, to settle my
 worldly affairs, I do authorize them the said Executors, to sell
 at publick or private sale or to rent out my house and lots
 in the Town of Williamston for the Benefit of my daughter
 Mary Eliza Falk and the unborn child which my wife
 Nancy Falk is now pregnant with either of which
 they may think best. In witness whereof I set my hand
 and seal: This the 3 day of January 1828
