I also give to my wife our horse he chose one brindle saddle two feather beds & furniture and beautiful ornaments one Walnut table two set. Hooks & mirrors and jewelry from one spider one kettle 2 pokers from 1 set pokers plates 1 set. Spoon two Bow & Calves two Chores two, two year old stags two year old Hens two Law & Hays brood sows two year old, sheep and all my Corn & Wheat that may be in hand also one half the crop growing also English Head of sheep to her & her heirs for ever.

Then I give to my son Joseph Roberson all my tract & parcel of land after the death of my wife to his mother with the privileges therein appertaining. I also give to my son Roberson all my working tools of every description one still one gun & the kindred of my stock of sheep one yoke of oxen one horse bridle & saddle one negro boy named Isaac to him & his heirs for ever.

Now I give to my son Joshua Roberson one negro boy Levi to him & his heirs for ever.

Then I have had to my daughter Mary Barry one negro boy named Dave during his life & then to his children if any but as there is no child no child's share of any. I then give to my two sons Joshua & Joseph Roberson the above named boy Dave, my daughter Mary Barry, have said her life estate in the said Dave. My son Joshua Roberson after the death of my daughter Mary Barry, my will that said boy be equally divided between my two sons & Joshua Roberson. I then give to my daughter Hannah Smith one negro girl named Agatha one bed & furniture two Bow & Calves two year old lamb, all of which she has right to her & her heirs for ever.

Then I have to my daughter Mary one negro boy named Sam I give to my daughter Mary one bed & furniture two Bow & Calves two year old lamb.

Then I have to my daughter Charlotte Roberson one negro girl named Isabella one bed & furniture two Bow & Calves two year old lamb.

Then I have to my daughter Betty one negro boy named Holland I give also to my daughter Betty one bed & furniture two Bow & Calves two year old lamb.

Then I have to my daughter Sarah Roberson one negro boy named Whitcomb I also give to my daughter Sarah one bed & furniture two Bow & Calves & two year old lamb.

I also have to my son Joseph Roberson one negro man named Mike to my son immediately after my death. My will & desire is that if any of my daughters above named dies without children lawfully begotten, of their part is that the property which I have put them in hands as the hands & families of their Brothers or Sisters take or return that hand children so that they may be equally divided among them.

Then I give to my daughter Sarah Mary Charlotte Tasty & Sarah after the death of my wife the following negroes (w) Sampson Ben. Mike after

one year Emma have & finally with her mother except one boy named Harry which I give to my son Joshua Roberson & later Equally divided among them so that they have & share alike. And for Executing this my last will & testament I constitute Joseph Roberson my executor of this my last will & testament I hereby revoke & disannul all others heretofore made ratifying & confirming this to be my last will & testament. My will should & delivered in the presence of us this 25th March the year of our Lord 1829.

Second - It is my will & desire that my Executor, hereafter named, shall sell any or all of my real property both real and personal at their own discretion for the purpose of making an equal distribution among the above named heirs.

Third and I hereby make & ordain my worthy friends John P. Bryan & James L. Bryan Executors of this my last will & testament, in witness whereof I the said Saml Hyman have to this my last will & testament set my hand & seal this day & year above written Signed sealed published & delivered in the presence of
