and about mill with two hundred acres of land adjoining the same also three negroes Ben, Amos & Harry during his natural life. I also give to my wife our horse he chose one brindle saddle two feather beds & furniture and beautiful ornaments one Walnut table two set. Hooks & trammels two frying pans one spider one kettle 2 pitch pans 1/2 doz pitch plates 1 doz spoon two Bow & Calves two Chores two brooms one old stove two year old Huger two saws & pig troughs two year old sheep and all my Corn & Wheat that may be in hand also one half the crop growing also English head of sheep to her & her heirs for ever.

Then I give to my son Joseph Roberson all my tract & parcel of land after the death of my wife with the priviledges thereto appertaining Great Mills & Saw Mill &c. also I give to my son Roberson all my working tools of every description one still one gun & the residue of my stock of sheep one yoke of oxen one horse bridle & saddle one negro boy named Isaac to him & his heirs for ever.

Then I give to my son Joshua Roberson one negro boy named Levi to him & his heirs for ever.

Then I have had to my daughter Nancy Barris one negro boy named Dave during his life & then to his children if any but as there is no child no child's heirs of any I then give to my two sons Joshua & Joseph Roberson the above named boy Dave, my daughter Nancy Barris have said her life estate in the said boy Dave. My daughter after the death of my daughter Nancy Barris, my will that said boy be equally divided between my two sons Joshua & Joshua Roberson I have given to my daughter Hannah Southwick one negro girl named Agatha one bed & furniture two Bow & Calves two yokes & lamb, all of which she has had to her & her heirs for ever.

Then I have had to my daughter Mary one negro boy named Sam I give to my daughter Mary one bed & furniture two Bow & Calves two cows & lamb.

Then I have had to my daughter Charlotte Roberson one negro girl named Isabella one bed & furniture two Bow & Calves two cows & lamb.

Then I have had to my daughter Patsy one negro boy named Holland I give also to my daughter Patsy one bed & furniture two Bow & Calves two cows & lamb.

Then I have had to my daughter Sarah Roberson one negro boy named Whitcomb I also give to my daughter Sarah one bed & furniture two Bow & Calves & two cows & lamb.

I also have had to my son Joseph Roberson one negro man named Mike ten years immediately after my death - my will & desire is that if any of my daughters above named die without children lawfully begotten of their body so that the property which I have put them in the hands & families of their Brothers or Sisters late or future that have children so that they may be equally divided among them.

Then I give to my daughter Hannah Mary Charlotte Tasty & Sarah after the death of my wife the following negroes (w) Dempsey Ben. Miles after -

two years I am now bound with her house except one boy named Harry which I give to my son Joshua Roberson to her equally divided among them so that they have & share alike - And for Executing this my last will & testament I do hereby appoint Joshua & Joseph Roberson my executors of this my last will & testament I hereby revoke & disannul all others heretofore made ratifying & confirming this to be my last will & testament. My will declared & delivered in the presence of us this the 25th March the 25th year of our lord 1829 -

Bryan Esqs of the my last will & testament, or either of them if one of them shall die before me to be my last will & testament set my hand & seal this day & year above written - Signed sealed published & declared in the presence of
