 of North Carolina being in perfect Sense and Memory do make and declare this to be
 my last Will and Testament. In the first place I recommend my soul into the hands of
 Almighty God and my body to be buried in decent Buriall in the first place my de-
 sires that all my Just Debts should be paid. Now I give and bequeath to my
 son Mary Anne one Negro Girl by the Name of Cassie and my three and the
 three of Mr. Williams's Negroes which is Eight hundred and thirty three and all the Money that
 is due me in Martin County after my Debts are paid forever And in the next place
 I give and bequeath to my wife Elizabeth three Acres one Negro Man named Will to be
 her Right and property. In the next place I give and bequeath unto George Fer-
 riss three hundred and thirty three Acres of the said Will to be his Right and property
 and bequeath unto William Payne my riding Saddle and all my wearing appar-
 el my Chest and Case and my Horse to be his Right and property in the next
 place my desire is that my beloved wife Mary Anne & my friend George Fer-
 riss should be the Executors of my last Will and Testament and I bequeath unto
 my friend that his twenty eighth day of December one thousand seven hundred and
 thirty three To be paid to the said

 to God for the same and calling to mind the Mortality of my body
 & knowing that it is appointed for all men Once to die do make
 and declare this my last Will and Testament. In
 Principal and first I full Give and recommend my soul unto
 the hands of God who gave it And for my body I recommend
 it to the Earth to be buried in a Grave of the Christian Man

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 and to the direction of my Executors Nathan Doubting but to give
 the same again at the proposed resurrection by the Mighty power of God
 and as touching such personal Estate as it shall please God to bestow
 within this life I give and dispose of the same in and from following
 that is to say my Will and desire is that all my Just Debts should be
 paid out of my Estate. Now I give and bequeath unto my son Nathan
 Bryan my father's Bed and all the Money of mine that he hath in his
 possession and one bow and Calf to him and his heirs forever
 Now I give and bequeath unto Sarah Packer my beloved Daughter one
 feather Bed and Furniture and all the Money that I have in the pos-
 session of Elias Bryan and all the Money due me in the State of
 George except what is in the hands of the said Nathan Bryan and
 one Huffer to her and her heirs forever
 Now I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Packer by Watson
 one Horse and saddle and bridle to her and her heirs forever
 And as for all the Remainder of my Estate my Will and desire is that
 should be Equally divided between my son Nathan and my Daughter
 Sarah after paying my Just Debts And I do hereby Ordain and appoint
 James Binnett Executor to this my last Will and Testament and I
 do hereby disavow revoke and annul all and singular other Wills
 legacies bequeaths by me made before this time Ratifying and Confirming
 this & testifying to be my last Will and Testament signed sealed published
 pronounced and declared by me to be my last Will and Testament
 in the presence of Jonathan Cherry Junr.
