 one Iron pot Kettle & Dish One two pewter Dish

my Loving son William Day son of John Day and Marroway his wife
at the Death of my wife Marroway Day my manners plantation
where on I now live and all the other hundred Acres on the wilcott
Road likewise one acre to him and his heirs for Ever
Then I Give unto my well beloved Daughter Mary Carter wife
of Benjamin Carter after the Death of my wife and further I Give
& Furniture to her and her heirs for Ever
Then I Give unto my well beloved Daughter Marroway Day
after the Death of my wife all my household goods and Cattle and
my stock of every kind Likewise one Negro boy named Jude to her
and her heirs for Ever
Then I Give unto my son Willis Day five Shillings Sterling
to be paid out of my Estate at my Death to him and his heirs
for Ever - Lastly I make Constitute Ordain and Appoint
my Loving wife Marroway Day and my Loving son William Day and
my friend Jesse Cooper to be My whole and sole Executors
of this my last will and Testament Revoking and Disannulling
all Other wills Before by me made Making and confirming
this and no Other be my last will and Testament In Witness
Whereof I have here unto set my hand and Appointed Seal this
thirtieth Day of March 1795
