 and my daughter Sarah Richmond and I give to be divided equally be-
 tween them my Slaves to wit John and Mary

In the Name of God Amen I William Ward of the State of Maryland
 County of Queen Anne being weak in body past of sound mind and memory
 do hereby certify that I have made this my last Will and Testament
 to wit: I give unto my Daughter Mary Thomas one Negro Girl named
 Sally to her and her heirs forever
 I then give unto my Daughter Sarah Riggs five Shillings to her and her
 heirs forever I then give unto my Daughter Ann Nicholas one Shilling to her and her
 heirs forever I then give unto my Daughter Thomas Riggs all that I intended for her
 portion in my last Will and Testament and that it may be evident
 according to this my last Will and Testament and I do give and bequeath
 all and every thing that I have made and acknowledged this to
 be my last Will and Testament whereunto I set my hand and seal this
