 authorizing him to convey to the purchaser absolute title for the
 same and out of the proceeds thereof to pay all my just debts
 I do give and bequeath to my blood wife Sarah and third
 of the balance of my estate remaining in the hands of my Executor
 after a settlement of my debts and the bequests hereunto contained
 I do give and bequeath to my child with whom my wife is
 now pregnant the other two thirds of my estate as aforesaid
 provided however said child arrives to the age of fifteen years
 should he or she die before that age then I give and bequeath
 the estate remaining in the hands of the Executor of my said
 child at his or her death to the children of the said child & his
 wife Martha who may be living at the death of my said child
 I do hereby give and bequeath to my child with whom my wife is
 now pregnant the other two thirds of my estate as aforesaid
 provided however said child arrives to the age of fifteen years
