Item 4th I give unto my grandson Arthur W. Stator one dollar to have & to hold forever

Item 5th I give unto my grandson Richard H. Stator one dollar to have & to hold forever

Item 6th I give unto my grandson David H. Stator one dollar to have & to hold forever

Item 7th I give unto my granddaughter Charlotte W. Stator one dollar to have & to hold forever

Item 8th I give unto my granddaughter Harriet H. Stator one dollar to have & to hold forever

I hereby make & ordain my son Kenneth C. Stator my executor to this my last will & testament revoking all other wills by me made in writing whomever I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal the day & date above written

In the name of God Amen I Thomas Reddick of the State of North Carolina and Martin County being of sound disposing mind and memory, being my dissolution now at hand, do hereby acknowledge this to be my last will and testament in manner & form following — first I recommend my soul into the hands of God that gave and design my body to the Earth whence it sprang, relying with fearless confidence in his mighty power to save, do hereby ordain and constitute this my last will & testament in manner and form following —

1st It is my will and desire that my body should be decently buried, and my funeral charges paid at the discretion of my Executors hereafter to be named

Item 1st It is my will and desire that all my just debts & contracts be complied with and the residue of my estate whatsoever may be disposed of in the following manner —

Item 2^d I bequeath unto my well beloved wife Polly Reddick my plantation where I now live during her life or widowhood — I also give unto my wife two beds and furniture — I also give unto my well beloved wife one man her choice also my farming utensils as she shall think necessary for carrying on her farm also the broken furniture as well surplus her business, also one fowling table, and one Bannet — I also bind unto my wife all the bookkeeping work. I also give unto my well beloved wife so much of my stock as will support her & the family — I also bind unto my well beloved wife all my negroes during her life or widowhood —

Item 3^d I give my plantation where I now live after the death of my wife unto my son Seth Reddick agreeable to my father's will —

Item 4th It is my will and desire that my two daughters Elizabeth Robinson and Emily Perry should not have any more of my household and kitchen furniture, more than what I have given them before the death of my wife —

Item 5th I give unto my well beloved daughter Polly Reddick one bed & furniture also one cow & calf and one chest —

Item 6th I give unto my well beloved daughter Sarah Reddick one bed and furniture, also one cow & calf and one chest
